Find in Desert Causes Stir Among Scientists

In a maddened depression near the ancient Pyramid of Degussa, seventeen miles north of Cairo, Egypt, a wonderful discovery has been made by the Egyptian department of antiquities.

Several stone statues were found in a heap at the top of a large sand-filled depression, some distance from any building. Their attributes, costumes and attitudes indicate that they are Syrian deities.
