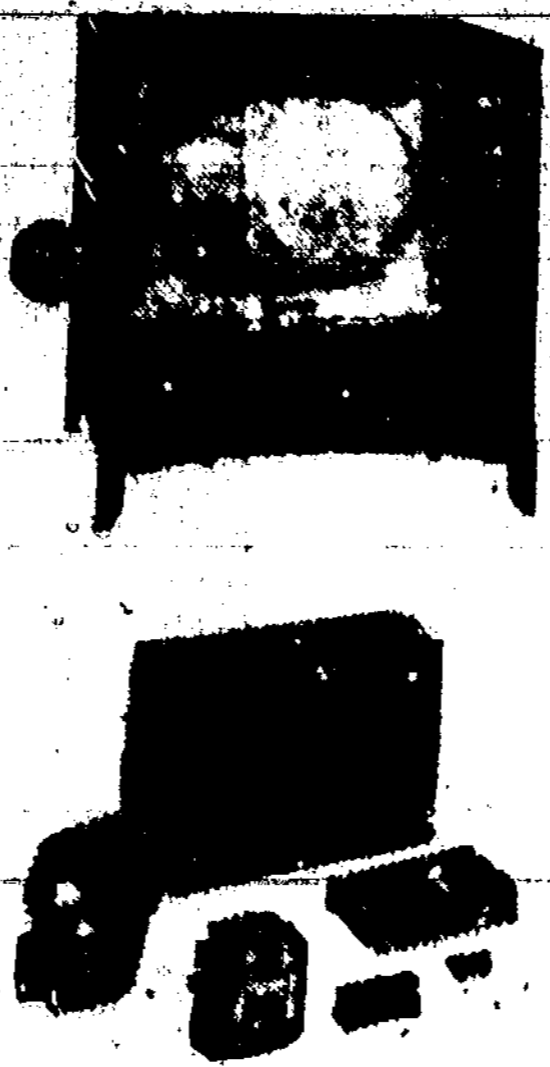

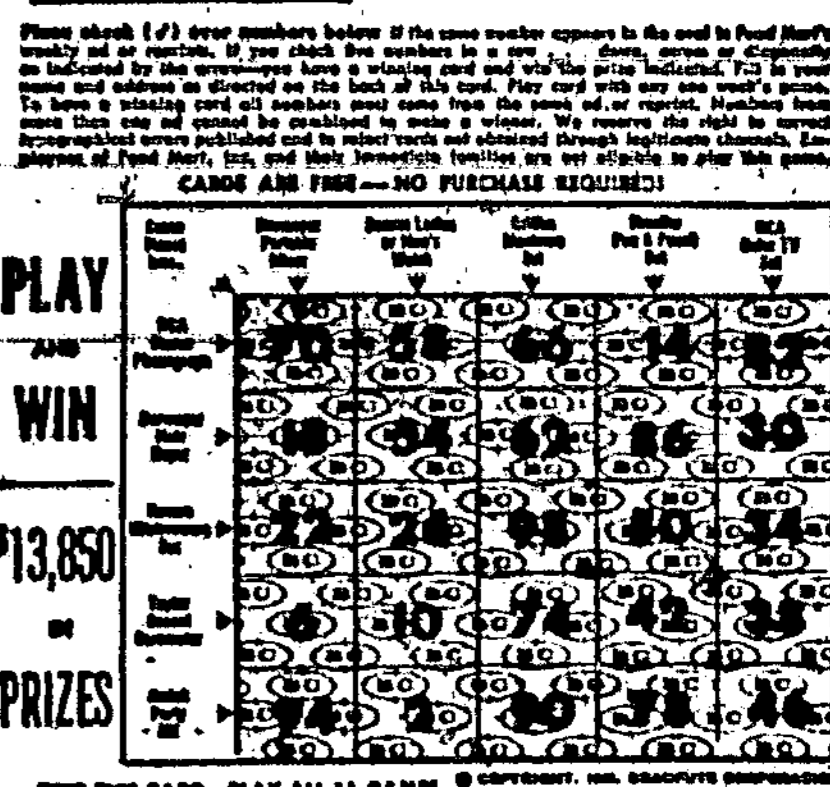

drawback - a sign warns you "Stream water not safe for drinking."

There is wood on hand, too, for your campfire if you are just picnicking and haven't the time to go out and gather it.

This is really a chain of campgrounds, too, as you first come to one area, but across the bridge is the larger area, with a public campground still further on.

There are two other forest camps within a couple of miles and just off the road.

You are bound to be able to find seclusion, if you want it, at one of these places and could drive to one of the others for facilities which you might prefer there. You could even hike the distance.
