The computerized system will improve the effectiveness of
the department. This move will the department. This move will
modernize the county law enforcement agency and make it comparable with top law enforcemient agencies in the natiqn. . LCCIC data ${ }^{*}$ will include arrest and jail records, evidence and stolen property lists
department budget and vehicle expense. The intelligence file will contain information on all known criminals and their activity,

LCCIC will facilitate work in preparing the UBniform Crime Reporting (UCR) that is sent to report is utilized by the FBI to record the national average on types of crime.

Part of the LCCIC process is the creation of a computerized 'outstanding warrant file'. In order for this program to suc-
ceed, it requires the cooperation of all the courts in Lincoln County. The Sheriff's Office.has contacted the nine judges (3 magistrate, 4 municipal and district) in the county to ask for their cooperation in the oul standing warrant file program.
Chief Deputy Sheriff Charles Cox sald that the program will make the courts more effective. Law enforcement agencles would avoid the possibibility of false arrest due to duplication of an arrest. Outatanding warran will be removed from the comperson named in the warrant is arrested.
Ontistanding warrants wirbe entered in the computer in mediately upon receipt.
