At Yes, rectal bleeding should always be investigated by a physictian in onder to find out the cause There are many causes of blecting from the gastrolntestinal fract, Bome are serious and some are not. The most common cause is hermoricholds. These can be removed surgically if pleeding persists or if they become symptomatic.

The most serious cause of such bleeding is cancer of the colon and rectum, About 60,000 people a year die from this cancer, Tanking it second to lung cancer as the leading cause of cancer-related deaths. Fortimately, early detection and treatment of colon cancer will while late diagnosis will lead to a very low cure rate.

Improved methods o detection of this cancer allow diagnosis. The simplest method is to test stools for blood which is invisible to the eye. This can be done at home by collecting stoil and putting a small amonut on a chemically treated card. Flexible tubes with lights and biopsy forceps have been -developed-which-makes-comiortable to-lookintothe colon and sample any suspiclous areas. Barium \(x\)-rays of colon can be used to outine suspicious areas for further evaluation.
