You remember Davy Crockett, frontiersman, crack shot, humorist who served with Andrew Jackson in the creek War, and who served two terms in the US Congress from Tentnessee. He couldn't let well enough alone, so he joined the Texas
forces and was dilled at the Alamo March 6,1836 , an incident the Mexicans came to regret. ''ve been browsing through a book, "The Life of Colonel David Crockett." A speech in the Hause of Representatives is, or should be, a classic. $\mathbf{A}$ bill had been introduced to benefit the widow of a distinguished naval officer. Congressmen spoke glowingly and favorably upon the bill, and it eemed certain to pass. Then it came Crocketi's time to speak:
"MR. Speaker. I have as much respect for the memory of Hiving, if suffering there be, as any man in this House, but we must not permit our respect for the dead or our sympathy for a part of the living to lead us into an act of injustice to the balance of the living. I will not go into an argument to prove that Congress has no power to appropriate this money as an act of charity. Every member upon this floor knows it. We have the we please in chartty: but as members of Congress we have no right to appropriatea dollar of the public money; . .

- "Some eloquent appeals have been made to us upon the ground that it is a debt due the deceased. Mr. Speaker, the deceased lived long after the close of the war; be was in office to
the day of his death, and I have never heard that the government the day of his death, and I have never heard that the government
was in arrears to him. This government can owe no debts but for services rendered, and at a stipulated price. If it is a debt, how much is it? Has it been audited, and the amount due ascertained? If it is a debt, this is not the place to present it for payment, or to have its merits examined. If it is a debt, we owe more than wee can ever hope to pay, for we owe the widow of
every soldier who fought in the War of 1812 precisely the same every soldier who fought in the War of 1812 precisely the same
amount.
"THERE is a woman in my neighborhood, the widow of as
gallant a man as ever shouldered a musket. He fell in battle. She is as good in every respect as this lady, and is as poor. She is earning her daily bread by her dally labor; and If I were to inbenefit. I should be laughed at, and my bill would not get five votes in this House.
"THERE are thousands of widows in the country just such as the one 1 have spoken of, but we never hear of any of these large debts to them. Sir, thita is no debt. The government did not owe it to the deceased wher he was alive; it could not contract it
after he died. I do not wish to be rude, butt I must be plain. Every man in this House knows it is not a debt. We tannot, without the grossest corruption, appropriate this money as the payment of a debt. We have not the semblance of authority to approprfate it as a charity. Mr. Speaker, I have said we have the right to give as much money of our own as we please, I am the poorest man on this floor. I cannot vote for this bill, but I will give one week's pay to the object, and if every Member of Congress will do the
same, it will amount to moze thar the biil asks;
