Although I have neve met him, 1 truly feel as though know him wheard of his case when wasteet the Soviet Union in Au informally with about a dozen people active in the Soviet Jewry movement, among them Galina cold me, through teart, tha Roald had been sentenced th in a labor cump in the North. He was conulcted of slander agains the Sovite state, but his real crime wha teaching Hebrew and wanting to emigrate.
