## Manager, attorney, road positions are 'opened'

Newly elected Lincoln County Commissioners took action during their first meeting Jan. 3 to open the positions of county manager, road superintendent.
"We want to hire these people who work for us," commissioner Karon Petty said. Her motion to open the three positions "so we can employ our personnel, was
approved unanimously. She asked that all three positions be filled by April 1, 1989. Petty said there may be people in the county who are interested in working for county government. Her
motion to accept the resignation of county manager Suzanne Cox was approved and Petty encouraged Cox to re-apply. Cox's resignation is to be effective April 1, 1989. Bob Hemphill was elected chairman for the first eight months. The commis-
sion decided to have a diffesion decided to have a diffe-
rent chairman for each eight rent chairman for each eight
months of their term. There will be no vice-chairman. Meetings will be held the second and fourth Mondays of themonth at 6 p.m. to "give working people the oppor tunity to attend the meetings." $A$ "relaxed agenda" wasiadopted that will include audience participation
