During one month, December 1968, 110 people made use of the hospital. Alton Whittaker, hospita admout 50 percent of cases admitted had the flu. The hub of the county hospital was the medical department under the direc tion of Dr. A.N. Spencer. A courtesy btaff of three medical doctors were permitted to ase the hospital facilities.
