Bill Vreeke of Bohannan Huston, engineers for the road project, said it would cost the county $\$ 12,000$ for temporary signs and tempor ary striping if the three-mile portion of the road was pened for traffic. Commissioners agreed Jan. 9 to table making a decision until the Jan. 23 meet ing to allow time for the com and visit with the Sierra

The water was metered as it entered the pipeline and

The 32 -year agreement was a "right of easement of flow" which is different than a contract. The agreement
allowed Capitan to pay a transmission fee and not to pay for the water itself. A problem arose last
