Battles Which
Made the World Gettyshurg

## The High Tide of the Southern Confederacy in

 which Pickett's Division performed one of theby CAPT. ROLAND F. ANDREWS
"Gettysburg, that terrible three days' battle
fought on the tirst, second and third days of July n 1863 , marked the turning point of the Amer wo years more, but it was Gettysburg which broke the military power of the South; which decided that the United States of America should endure, the united country of a free people. Gettysburg was "the high tide of the Confederacy."

Gettysburg lies in Pennsylvania, about thirty-
miles southwest of Harrisburg. A sleep tire miles southwest of Harrisburg. A sleepy
