The committee, representatives of the Forest Service and Department of State Frorestry (agenclis which assisted with organization of the which assisted with organization of the group), began finalizing plans for the Red group), began finalizing plans for the Red Flag Alert and evacuation map distribution, Ray Pulaski, state forestry, told the committee the Red Flag Alert Progra should be complete by February 1979, should be complete by February 199, estimating the total materials cost at about $\$ 1,600$. He itemized costs at $\$ 270$ for 10,000 printed handouts, $\$ 1,194$ for 200 magnetic signs and $\$ 145$ for material for 400 flags.
