Ruidoso's voters may soon be asked to approve a $\$$ million general obligation bond issue to bulld a new ewer system and replace about two miles of tran smission Hines demolished in the December flood.

The trustees could try to find a buyer for revenue bonds in that amount. Financial information avallable to the village indicates this would be difficult; if not im possible.

Either way, the $\$ 1$ million must be repaid.

Based on the fact that Ruidoso's growth resulted in a four mill drop in property taxes from 1977 to 1978, and on the virtual certainty that the bullding boom will con tinue, it is possible that a $\mathbf{\$ 1}$ million general obligation bond issue would not increase the present tax rate.

Soon, the choice could be yours to force the village into trying to sell revenue bonds which, if sold, would result In an Immediate Increase in the cost of sewer service or, take the chance that a $\$ 1$ million general obiligation bond issue won't raise taxes.

There doesn't seem to be much choice in the matter espectally If the general obligation bonds won't cost us any more than we're paying now. -CD
