 that weren't convention delegates.In addition, the area was the unwilling host to approximately 300 to 400 members of motorcycle organizations generally reported to engage in Illegal activities - Including flaunting of most of our behavorial laws.

The amazing thing, concerning all of these people, in cluding the undesirables, is that Ruidoso's police records show there were but 71 arrests made. The majority on misdemeanor charges: drinking in public, disturbing the peace and minor traffic infractions.

More amazing is the fact, taken from police records, that only four of those arrested were undesirables. The balance were local residents, including a sprinkling of isiting cyclists who were involved in minor traffic violations

A total of seven accidents, Involving motorcycles, were eported. No serious injurles, autside of one broken ieg. esulfed

This relatively peaceful situation resulted from the large numbers of State Police and Mounted Patro members assisting the Sheriff's department and local police in enforcing our laws.

Officers were everywhere - at ail times. This high visibility obviously reduced the number of law violations and kept allercations to a minimum

We congratulate all of the law officers involved for the fforts in keeping Ruidoso/Ruldoso Downs as safe for veryone concerned as it was humanly possible to do. Ne are most appreciàtive. -CD
