Though the lines for lift tickets and the lifts were long, the new facilities reduced time walting to a minimum.

Lodging operators contacted over the weekend by The News indicated that most were booked to capacity, with cancellation being virtually nonexistent.
The number of skiers at Sierra Blanca over the weekend is currently running a littie less than estimated last week by manage Roy Parker.
Parker was anticipating selling between 15,000 and 20,000 tickets
by the end of today, but so far only about 9,000 have been sold.
Parker said the resort sold 3,515 on Sunday and 3,237 on Saturday Friday's total was around 3,000 .

What's It Like To Have A Chimney Fire? it's no fun. If it doesn't burn the house down, it will probably wreck your chimney and scare you half to death. Here's how it happens.
Begin with one dirty chiminey - let's say a fireplace not cleaned for a couple of years. The soot lining the chimney nue is saturated with flammable stuff called creosote. [More detail on creosote is available in any dictionary.] It doesn't take much to ignite creosote - a newspaper fire sending flames up to the damper is enough.
Once kindled, creosote burns with joyous abandon. In a matter of seconds the fire spreads up through the flue creating a draft that only helps things along. At this point our average chimney fire begins to roar and howl, sending

If you run, you'll be treated to a real fireworks show. As he creosote fire builds and intensifies the heat melts the mortar between the brick. The red-hot mortar actually drips into the five, olly to be caugh up in the remendous updraft, and these litte fire balis shoot out the chimney and onto the one end of the building - if you're not, this miniature volcano can end of the building - if you'ren use down
However, if you stand your ground, a chimney fire can be controlled. Put out the fire in the fireplace with an exthe fire department, and hope for the test. But it should be pointed out that having your chimney cleaned is, a lot easier on the nerves than the sand and wet blanket method.

As interesting as first thoughts about the possibility that the Ruldoso Downs Baptist Church may open "a non-denominational Christian school" are, it is not a panacea to solving:the problems of increasing enrollment in the Ruidoso Public Schools.

A parochial school is not eligible for public funding, therefore it would have to.be supported by sub scription and, more than likely, stiff tuition fees which would tend to limit enrollment.

Therefore, to handle the projected increase in students in the public school in the years ahead, the Board of Education must continue with their plans to expand the present facillties.

Based on a five percent annuat population growth the public school must be able to educate 1,90 students by the beginning of the 1985-86 school year and possibly \(\mathbf{2 , 3 0 0}\) or more in another five years.

If the voters approve bonding the school disfirict to the legal limit, then the school can apply to the State Capital Outlay Committee for substantla funding that need not be repald, to complete the building program.

Sure, the bond issue will increase taxes, but, if Ruidoso is to continue offering students out standing educational opportùiltles, sichoot district patrons must foot their share of the cost. There is, it seems, no alternative. - CD
