One-upmanship is the name of the game in the heavens and with the success of space shuttle Columbla, the United Sfates has surged ahead of the Soviet Unlon In the race for space supremacy.

We must now await news of the eventual use to which the Columbla wIII be put, with that use, assuredly to be a thorn in the side of the Soviets - and you can wager that's what they'll so procialm.

Should the Columbla be employed in strictly peaceable pursuits, then the Russians will have no complainfs coming. Should it be employed to better determine wha underhanded schemes the Russians might be up to, then we'll have no complaints coming.

If the Columbia is pressed into service as a scheduled space shuttle, to man and maintain an orbiting space craft, scientists may galn greater insight into the mysteries of the universe. Just how this knowledge, if gained, will benefit our relations with the Russians remains to be seen, but If our gamesmanship is superior to theirs we'll gain stature in the eyes of the nonCommunist nations in the world - which can't help but bolster President Reagan's administration.

It's for certain that the Russians won't take this standing on the ground, and ere long they'Il try and dupilcate this latest Unlfed States feat in space.

Playing catch up, however, won't be as face saving as the launching of Sputnik was to the Russians some 25 years ago. However, Spuinik is of no Importance now, what's Impartant is how the Columbla fares in the future and what problems might arise in dealing with the Russians as we establish the United Stafes as the dominate force in space.

And if the end result is that Brezhnev burshes up on his diplomacy, Columbla will be worth much more to the United States than lits cost. - CD
