Ine murder mystery. but it lunctions merely as the device 10 set up the predictable situallons. The atlitude the film expresses toward gays is more curlous. Ninety percent af the film seems to emphasize antigay jokes and snide remarks. Only at the end does Hurt prove himself to be more than
the butiof these he butl of these jokes.
O'Neal captures the embarrassment! of any straight man asked to pose as a gay. Hurt's. sensilive, but rather cliched. portrayal of a homosexual is nuineless effective.
Bul essentially the film is a one-note joke that some will will find somply hate, but mos willind simply diverling. One's altude about the film may lem fom where one stano on gay rights
