## Editorial

The town of Los Alamos will: vote January 11 on a strict smoking ordinance.

We hope the ordinance passes, and that it sets a trend which other municipalities in the state will follow:

The law would ban smoking in a number of public places, including retail food and drug stores, libraries, schools, hospitals and other health-care centers. It would also require resfaurants to provide non-smoking areas.

The tobacco industry has argued that smoke from another person's cigarette, cigar or pipe has not been proven harmful. Of course, .that industry does not even acknowledge that smoking harms the person doing it.

Questions of health aside, non-smokers have a moral right to eat a meal at a restaurant without someone ruining it by lighting up at the next table. This right should be recognized by law everywhere.

And, in Ruidoso, citizens should be able to attend a meeting of their governing body and sit close enough to see and hear what is going on without coming out of the meeting with their clothes reeking of smoke.

Progressive-minded business owners and village officials could accommodate non-smokers without being required to by law. If they fail to do so, there is no reason that a citizens group cannot bring about a smoking ordinance here, as has happened in Los Alamos.-TP
