"You can accept losing if the game was well played," said McGuire. The game just concluded was not particularly well played, he added.

The representative acknowledged that the gover nor brought some of his troubles on himself. But the lawmakers who disagreed with Anaya attempted to make that point at all costs.

Conflict makes good copy for newspapers, whether it be in Santa Fe or at Ruidoso village hall. But we hope this spring brings more cooperation and less discord to both chambers of government.-TP

When Donald F. Smith was searching for the best horse barns to in-
stall at Ruidoso Downs, he had a very simple guideline.
"I've always put myself in the posi"I've always put myself in the posi-
tion of the horsemen. What kind of a barn would I want if 1 had horses running at Ruidoso Downs,"'said, Smith
general manager of Ruidoso Downs general manager of Ruidoso chowns
Race Track. "We had bids on cheaper horse barns, but the kind of barns would want to put my horses in if 1 With that in mind, Ruidoso Downs has started work on building eight new barns in the area at the bottom of track kitchen complex.
The new barns replace antiquated The new barns replace antiquated
barns which have been leveled. barns which have been leveled. least one feed room (measuring eight by 12 feet) on a side, and perhaps two
on a side depending upon each barn's dimensions. talls, including 60 tack rooms, leaving approximately 250 stalls for outer perimeter for the barns as well as for each stall.
"Each stall will be 12 feet by 12 feet. size for a race horse. If you go any maller than that, a big horse won't d. Smith said the barns are being built
by the Mn Enterprises, which was
founded in 1975 and has locations in
the major horse areas in the continental United States with representatives in Hawaii, Canada and Venezuela. looking at their operation, how they built their barns and other factors: I then, suggested to the Board of Direccors (of Ruidoso-Sunland) that this
would be, the best company for us' to use They agreed and then we sought and received approval from the New
Mexico Racing Commission "Our new barns will be as good or better than the barns of any racetrack in the state of New Mexico," he add-
Smith cited the Boyle Engineering Company in Albuquerque with designing-the-engineering plans

"After July, it usually rains quite Ait in Ruidosos and causes flooding in that part of the barn area. We're trying to handle the drainage problem in
the barn area step by step. This is the first stage of our hopes to eventually

barn area. The Boyle people helped us considerably with the drainage factor as well as numerous other aspects of
our new plans." Smith noted our new plans," Smith noted.

and J. Doyal Roberts, who have raced at Ruidoso Downs for more than two
