Mandatory Spanish danguage programs in the state's public schools?

We oppreciate Gavernor Toney Anaya's desire to implement süch a tequirement from the standpoint that school children should be exposed to foreign languages. There are several problems with the ided; however.

The first was raised by state School Superintendent Leonard DeLayo. "The single, most important function of the public schools is to teach kids how to read, write and speak the English language so thit they may compete in the American marketplace." DeLayo said.
DeLayo evidently is concerned with the students for whom English is a struggle, and feels that having to take Spanish could deter their ability to master English.

Another problem is that 'the students' languogelearning efforts would be directed toward one language, to the exclusion of others. Enriched programs in Latin and French and other torigues presumably would not be required by law.

Spanish is the best second language for most to know in New Mexico, obviously. It is encouraging that enriched Spanish learning programs like the one in Albuquerque that attracted the governar's attention are being started.

Nothing precludes a local school district that wants to from implementing such programs now. Therefore, there is no point in trying to make them mandatory statewide.-TP
