## Can You Name Something

 That's Gone Down in Price Lately?How about oil and gas?
When President Reagan removed price controls on crude oil and gasoline in 1981, some critics predicted spiraling oil prices and $\$ 3.00$ gasoline.

However, since that time oil has dropped from $\$ 37$ to $\$ 27$ a barrel and is still falling. Gasoline went from $\$ 1.39$ to $\$ 1.24$ a gallon between June 1981 and 1985. (That meant the consumer paid less despite a $54 \%$ jump in gasoline taxes during that same four-year period.)

So too with natural gas: When the 1985 New Mexico Legislature voted to eliminate State price controls on intrastate natural gas in July for the first time in eight years, opponents predicted a price fly-up.
However, utility and producer reports indicate that natural gas prices, which had been rising steadily for several years, are now declining in New Mexico.
Although one may argue about the economic factors underlying oil and gas prices, one thing is certain: The American private enterprise system operates most fairly and efficiently when it is most free of political and bureaucratic interference. With the eventual lifting of all federal price controls, the petroleum industry will be able to rejoin other businesses in selling its products in the competitive market place.
