Not every coming election is home free. .Take the case of District Judge Richard A Parsons.
Parsons is not allowed to establish a platform, or to state his political affiliation and he judge candidates, he shares an easy to miss position at the very bottom of the voting ballot. District judges run for re-election strictly District judges run for re-election strictly
on the public perception of their past judicial
records, Parsons said.

It wasn't always that way
Just six years ago, judges ran their reelection campaigns like everyone else. They
were Republicans and Democrats and they faced fepub and blood opponents, not the ghosts of their judicial records

But in an effort to remove the judicial process from political pressure and special inter-
est leverage, New Mexico in 1985 joined 41 other states by passing a version of what is other states by passing
called the Missouri Law.
That amendment to the state constitution
requires that 49 of the 59 district requires that 49, of the 59 district judges in New Mexico every six years ask voters in a
non-partisan election to retain them based on their courtroom performances.
If the voters say no, a complicated process of selecting a successor is kicked into motion. As Parsons explained the procedure, a non partisan committee is formed to handle the
review of all applicants for the soon-to-be review of all applicants for the soon-to-be
vacant judgeship.
The committe is comised of ponte ap
pointed by the State Supreme Court, the State Court of Appeals, the governor, the State Bar Association and the presidents of the state Senate and House of Representatives. The chairman. The presiding judge of the district also serves on the committee.

boys," but they soon find out that sitting in the corner ain't gonna cut the mustard. Its like the old saying among salesmen ... "You're not going to make any sales sitting around the ofIf on
If one intends to sell a community or county who can make the decision to locate an industry in that community or county.
It is a majordecision for an entrepreneur to-
relocate his or her business to a new relocate his or her business to a new community. it not only involves a signincant exing perhaps several families, the sole of real estate, and a change of schools and friends for younger family members.
These steps are not likely to be taken light1y. The entrepreneur must have a great deal of
confidence that such a move vill ignificantly connidence that such a move whil signinicantify
benefit, not only lis business, but also the life style of his family.


There are two elements that instill the confidence necessary for a decision to move. The first is the actual ammenties of the community itself. Is it indeed a good place to live? Are there good schools and ghopping conveniences? the population in general, and elected officials specifically, support the growth of industry in the community? How about tax and utility rates? Transportation? And the list goes on
and on. and on.

most desirable hurling motion, as it puts the east amount of strain on the arm.
