## Springer: out of sight, out of mind

It is a potential powder keg, and the news media have ignored it altogether - at least to date. Nonetheless, a chilling 8 -month old
report prepared by the former-Medical Direcreport prepared by the former-Medical Direc-
tor of the New Mexico Youth Authority is tor of the New Mexico Youth Authority is government and ought alarm those in the the state's juvenile corrections system.
The report was commissioned by the then-
Secretary of the New Mexico Youth Authority, Secretary of the New Mexico Youth Authority, Jackie Riggs, late in former-Gov. Garrey Car-
ruthers' term of office. Its author is the ruthers term of office. Its author 18 the
respected University of New Mexico professor of medicine, Dr. Ben Daitz.
According to Daitz' report, problems are rife throughout New Mexico's juvenile corrections system, but are "most gerious and compelling"
at the New Mexico Boys' School near Springer. (Interestingly, Daitz contract as part-time Medical Director to the Youth Authority has not been renewed since submitting his report.) What the Daitz Report details, after a comprehensive examination, is a situation nothing less than explosive at Springer: a "warehouse
for troubled kids" where "residents are not safe" and sexual assaults and other forms of violence are commonplace.
At the heart of the problem, the report concludes, are "three major potentially correctable problems ${ }^{\text {n }}$-The Boy
-The Boys' School at Springer is ahockingly over-crowded and under-staffed. Designed
for 181 residents, at the time the Daitz Report was prepared Springer housed a population of 273, forcing "an already understaffed facil. ity...to supervise, at times, over 100 residents more than capacity." This, the report notes, "in
outdated and structurally-deficient cottages
 alone privacy.

-More still, the report continues, staff training and supervision throughout the state's juvenile system is woefully inadequate, "inconsistent and largely urregulated." Once again, the most disturbing conditions are at
S pringer. where staffers have formed "almost Springer. where staffers have formed "almost
independent kingdoms with different philosophies and agendas" concerning such fundamental matters as therapy for substance abuse and mental health problems which are often found in youth committed to that facility. (Boys' School) of staff using unnecessary force (Boys School) of staf using unnecessary force
to subdue residents." report concludes,
-Finally, the "Psychological treatment report concludes, Psychological treatment services within the
N.M. Youth Authority (are) practically nonexistent." In consequence, "severely troubled and mentally ill children are not being afforded the opportunity of treatment, under the present

The N.M. Youth Authority was created as a cabinet-level department directly under the governor three years ago, thanks in large

Ruben Smith (D. Dona Ana). Until that time,

gram or their predecessors - the N.M. Boys amd Girls' Schools, probation and parole, based youth offenders' facilities around the statewere part of the adult corrections system puders, Rep. Bob Hawk (D. Bern.), nit wa pwer that the handling of youth simply had to be separated from the adult aystem because frankly, the needs of children and youth were being treate.
What makes the Daitz Report so disturbin is the evidence it presents that youth correc tions may remain a second thought in state governmental affairs. Moreover, at least in oft the-record private conversation, many close to present state officials - including past and dent that the present secretary of the N.M. Youth Authority is the person most apt to turn the situation around. Before Gov. Bruce King appointed him to head the department, Robert
Portillos was the longtime superintendent at Springer where some the most serious problems are reported to exist.
In any event, not many who have seen Dr. Daitz' report appear ansious to quibble with its findings.
"Ihe report," says Rep. Hawk, "is on Larget.
More bothersome still, preliminary investigations by this reporter and his colleagues at Sunmount Syndicate incline us to suspect the situation may be even worge than Daitz has reported.
