than a hardware store which primanly than a hardware store which primanly
relies on what the market will bear. Over the centuries, people have devel-
oped a reverential attitude toward hospithem. business. The traditional public hospital owned by local government and account-
able directly to the voter is disappearing, to able directly to the voter is disappeaning, to
be replaced by privately-owned, profit be replaced by privately-owned, profit-
making corporations. That business atmosphere often affects the types of service offered and the level of hospital charges.

Cost is not necessanily the only consider-
Other factora are tital.
Other factors are the range of services
available, the average cost per patient day available, the average cost per patient day,
the number of employees for each patient bed, the cost of key services, the location of the facility and its overall comparison to other hospitals in the area are all impor-
The Lincoln County Medical Center compares favorably in gervices with other community pride.

the consumer frustration over spiraling medical costa.
Every consumer has the right to make an informed decision on hospital care and
the availability of that information is woefully inadequate.

\section*{What's the point?}

We have a councilor who likes to ask, "What's the point?"

When some were critical of Councilor Ron Andrews for-profit motorcycle rally being subsidized by lodgers tax funds and costing the village no telling what fo security, traffic control and cleanup, Andrews com mented that he made a profit, so "what's the point?"

That's a \(\$ 2,500\) question - or maybe a \(\$ 2,000\) or even a \(\$ 1,500\) question depending on whether you're promoting a bikers rally or you're concerned about animal control for the village or even if you're promoting Christmas Jubilee, à non-profit Christmas event sponsored by the Ruidoso Valley Greeters There are several issues here.

First the \(\$ 2,500\) question: we join Andrews in standing up for the right of any business person to make a profit. Such free enterprise is what makes America great. But, we don't believe that tax money should be used to assure a profit for a private enter prise. That's one point.

Second: the \(\$ 2,000\) question: we differ with Andrews and the souncil on refusing to increase the monthly contract with the Humane Society and then forcing the Society to spend \(\$ 2,000\) for workmen's compensation insurance. Since that requirement is over and above state and federal regulations, and since the village usually doesn't dictate such requirements to a contractor, we question why it's being done this time.

This village used to spend much more for animal control than is currently being expended under the contract with the Humane Society, and still councilors are asking the society to open its books regarding funding sources in addition to the village contract. It's unusual for a contractor providing a service to be required to open its books regarding other sources of in comes.

Seems that Andrews, who happily takes tax money to support his for-profit venture, is taking the lead on keeping the Human Society's contract at last year's level and adding additional expenses. He also was a party to approving a Lodgers Tax Committee budget that gave the Christmas Jubilee just \(\$ 1,500\). That's a lot less than the Greeters, a volunteer, non-protit group, requested, and they had to go back twice to even get that much. It's also \(\$ 1,000\) less than Ron got for his own event.

We have to ask, "So, what's the point, Ron?"

A. Your question is incredibly timely, Tom. It just so happens I was talking to the noted celebrity author, Mark Bego, about his newest book, "One is the Loneliest Number" which Jimmy wrote with Mark. (The publisher is Pharos Books.) Jimmy doesn't pull his punches either with his stories about the band and what went on behind the scenes during the early days of Los Angeles' emerging rock culture. He's equally frank with his own story, from his privileged childhood, on through his experiences with the band, his drug addiction that brought him to bankruptcy and nearly ended his musical career, to the point at which he finally asked for help and began the slow, often painful climb out of his personal depths.
