## Everything you wanted to know about rattlesnakes but were afraid to ask

It's that time of year again. Warm weather is bringing out some critters that most people just don't want to meet. Probably the highest dangerous kind like rattlesnakes.
Over the years, because little was known about rattlers, there have been numerous legends that people tend to accept as facts about rattilesnakes. To learn more abo
tlesnakes, let's first take a little test

Even though most of the above statements are commonly believed about rattlesnakes, they are all false. Let's look at some of the the fear shrouding these reptiles.
he fear shrouding these reptiles.
At birth, baby rattlesnakes have one button or rattle that it not exposed until it sheds it Then, each time it sheds its skoin it adds an other rattle. In some areas of the country this occurs once or twice each year, but in southern areas it may be as high as four or five times a year. In addition, few rattlesnakes are able to keep their string of rattles intact. They often lose segments due to normal wear and tear, so a snake with over 10 rattles is very rare even though it may be over 20 years old.


A cailed rattlesnake may or may not "buzz" before it strikes. Why a snake rattles is not fully understood, but they don't always rattle. Thanism that they developed to keep from chanism that they developed to keep from being stepped on by larger animals, such as
the 100 million bison that once roamed the plains. Rattlesnakes, like all other snakes have dry combined with muscular action push against the ground to move the snake, and contrary to popular belief they can swim and crawl easily over ropes around camps. One way to tell if a swimming snake is a rattier is to look for the rattles, it holds them above the water when it
swims. Rattlers are pit vipers and have infrared-heat-sensing pits located between the nostrils
and eyes. New studies suggest that these and eyes. New studies suggest that these
organs are used to detect predators and help supply information on whether the predator is supply information on whether the predator is that the snake would be better off retreating (like in most cases with people). In the past it was believed that heat sensing was used basically to locate prey, but the new study suggest this is secondary to defense. In reality snakes trail their prey down using smell. THe forked
tongue goes out, touches the ground, then retreats into little sensory holes in the roof of
the snake's mouth so it "smells". These are the the snake's mouth so it smells. These are the poorly developed and hearing is almost nonexistent.
Before striking, a rattlesnake normally coils into an $S$ shape with its head and neck pointed at the target. They can only strike a
distance of $1 / 3$ to $1 / 2$ of their length. They open distance of $1 / 3$ to $1 / 2$ of their length. They open
their mouth before striking and the their mouth before striking and the hypodermic like tangs swing out to inject the
venom. The
The venom injected is actually modified saiva that contains many digestive enzymes ven newborn rattlers are able to inject a its prey by breaking down blood cells and body tissues. It kills through internal bleeding by stopping blood clotting, by shock, and kidney or respiratory failure. This may happen quick y in small animals, but takes time in humans That's the reason that even though about each year in the US only 10 to 15 sis The each year in the U.S. only 10 to 15 die. The The "Ive been bitten by a rattler so is shock to die." syndrome.
Remember you have a better chance of drowning in a bathtub than dying from snakebite. The best thing to do is to keep calm and get to a doctor. Even if it may take a long time to get to the doctor, you are not likely to tirne
die.

Fear of rattlesnakes has really created myths and legends. Rattlers aren't superhuman and are not an animal to be highly feared. It is also not necessary to kill them on sight, they

## Editorial

## Businesses should pay their own way

Welfare isn't just for the poor. Government dollars are pouring into the hands and pocket books of pri vate enterprise at an alarming rate.

It's becoming commonplace for every level of government to contract for feasibility studies over everything imaginable.

Millions of dollars are going into some deep dark hole somewhere and coming out'as loose leaf books and binders filled with bits and pieces of public in formation that any resourceful reporter could gather in a matter of a few days.

We've said it before; but research undertaken here last week led us back down a circular primrose path o government giving money to private groups to be used for studies. And then, if the Ironhorse Railroad study is any example, the results of those expensive studies are basically ignored, while fundralsing efforts go forward.

Using the Ironhorse Railroad study as an example the state paid $\$ 40,000$, the village contributed $\$ 4,900$ and Economic Development Corporation of Lincoln County "loaned" $\$ 8,000$ to spend more than $\$ 50,000$ to learn if the $\$ 200$ million railroad would be feasible. The well-paid researchers waltzed around that question every way they could to tell those nice folks that paid them that, sure, it could be done - BUT, it wouldn't service any debt, public funds aren't avail able, right of way acquisition would be impossible, engineering would be a nightmare and environmenta and geological studies would be required at an addiional high cost. Does that sound feasible to you? In spite of being very well-paid, the studiers just couldn't make it sound feasible.

What's next for the Ironhorse group? Apparently more fundraising, more studies and, perhaps, more public money. As long as the promoters stay out of the taxpayers pocketbooks, we say more power to them. But, no more public funds should bé used

Meanwhile, an even more expensive study is under way to determine the feasibility of siting a high level nuclear waste storage facility in this area. How do you think a researcher will say "no way" to a group that is handing out money in the hundreds of thousands and even millions?

On the other hand, some smaller enterprises are being undertaken here this summer by entrepreneurs using their own funds and NO TAX MONEY! Three cheers for the developers of Miner's Castle Mountain Music, Rakocy's Museum and Art Gallery, the Brass Horse Barn and other enterprising business owners who put their own money to work using good old Yankee ingenuity.
