

City of Alamo tapped rum regional landfill

Ruidoso News Staff Writer The regional landfill to be shared by Lincoln and Otero counties will be operated as a de-

partment of the city of Alamogordo. And strong commercial accounts should help to keep the cost of using the landfill down for member

cities and counties. The Otero Solid Waste Authority and the Lincoln County Solid Waste Authority, which represent eight separate towns and two county governments, sealed the future of the operation Thursday during a joint meeting in Ruidoso.

"We have agreed that the landfill will be operated as a division of Alamogordo city government, as a department," said attorney J. Robert Beauvais, who represents the Lincoln authority.

was approved tentatively and will be fine tuned by Alamogordo to be approved (by that city council).

"We felt it was important that the landfill be under public ownership and operation. We will not be dealing with any vendors in the operation of the landfill, but each entity can collect and transport as they desire.

Authority members also are looking at the feasibility of establishing transfer stations, possibly in Tularosa or Carrizozo. Consultant Dave Warren is examining the time and money factors.

LCMC prescribes recycling throughout

at Lincoln County Medical Center. it's a way to work together, making the hospital as efficient as possible

Mike Gray, director of plant services, along with his crew have developed many ways for all departments of the hospital to do their part to recycle and help the environment. A display on all the recycling projects is set up in the lobby of the hospital and will be up through the end of the week.

Gray, who is also president elect of the New Mexico Society for Hospital Engineering, said the hospital is probably leading the state in this effort, in part because of the county recy ling program through the Lincoln County Solid Waste Authority. Recycling containers

aluminum and white paper are stationed around the hospital, but they also collect cardboard, glass, plastic and steel cans. Gray said by recycling it has reduced the waste flow by about 32 percent, which is about 28 tons a year.

The plant services department has also started an xeriscaping taking up landfill space Gray said field, where there is little or no water use and little or no mowing necessary. Gray said they plant grasses and trees that are native to area and need little

maintenance. The area is behind the hospital

The hospital also uses energy ef ficient lighting, which in some areas can reduce energy consumption by up to 80 percent. Gray said cooler burning lights also mean less energy needed for air-conditioning They are currently looking for someone to take fluorescent lighting tubes to recycle, he said.

Whenever it is possible, they try to use environmentally safe chemicals, including wood stains made from plant oils and bee's wax. The sewer and vacuum line cleaners are also made of completely safe en-

Gray said ozone depleting CFC's for (chlorofluorcarbons) can now be recovered, recycled and reused. When it is possible they try to replace any refrigeration equipment with CFC free equipment.

Crown encouraged directors to all help greet the Alamogordo Ambassadors at 8:30 a.m. Thursday to welcome to the area.

Jack Muhn, contract accountant for the chamber, said the chamber has had an \$8,664 loss so far this year but by the end of the fiscal year it will be closer to \$1,000 above or below budget. He said he is expecting another big dues billing to make up for the loss they experienced in the first three months of the year.

Although he didn't expect it to be a "rose garden," Muhn said the chamber won't have the shortfall it did last year when it suffered close to a \$17,000 loss during that year.

Activity at the chamber has also been at a steady increase from last year, which was a bumper year. March was up 16 percent from 1992, while February was up 19 percent. January saw a 22 percent increase in total activity.

Director James Hobbs thanked the board directors who participated in the volunteer program he and director Clark Carpenter organized for the chamber. Volunteers from among the directors and general membership come in for a few hours a day to help the chamber staff in whatever way is needed, such as answering phone calls or mailing packets.

The program gives the volunteers a better understanding of how the chamber operates.

With more funds coming in than in past years, Kopp has been working on several projects to bring more businesses to the county. She said she has plans for two direct marketing campaigns, one in coupon redemption and a second in telemarketing.

Kopp estimates the cost to do both would be about \$5,000 and they will be using a local business to prepare the material. In a direct marketing campaign the information on Lincoln County would go straight to the chief executive officer, she said.

Kopp has also met with a representative of southern hotels recently to discuss the possibility of a corporation building one near the Civic Events Center. She put the representative in contact with R.D. Hubbard, who has the contract to build a hotel there until July.

After several changes in a proposal to move to a new location in the Stroud Building, which was approved at the last board meeting, Kopp will look into other possible locations which will save the group some funds. The rent on the current office is increasing and the board was told it could get the smaller office for the same price it is currently paying, \$350.

Kopp said with the cost of utilities and a common area maintenance charge the group will only be saving \$140 by moving to the smaller office. The group has its own furniture and would only need two office rooms. She wants to be moved out of the current office by

Life as Mining Engineer

Before his marriage, Lynn attended Colorado School of Mines at Golden, Colorado He graduated in the Class of 1902 as class preadent and also class poet

This was fitting because although he was gifted in mathematics, engineering and science, he remained, in addition to all his talents, at heart a poet.

And although he rose to the top of his profession as petroleum geologist, he found time for writing


As a mining engineer, mining geologist and government surveyor, he went twice to Alaska, first to Valdez and then to Juneau. Later he went to Mexico where he made surveys of mines and worked for a silver smelter.

A School Mate Turns the Tide

After he returned from Mexico, Lynn found himself one day in San Antonio, Texas, where he met one of his school mates from the Colorado School of Mines who said he had changed from mining to petroleum geology and advised father to do the same, that many of the School of Mines men had done the same.

Father soon became a geologist for the Sun Oil Company. When his brother, Jerome, heard this, he said, "That company is lucky. When they get Lynn, they get brains and they get honesty.'





Father worked for the Sun Oil Company 40 years until the age of 75 - 10 years past the retirement age.

The attitude of the company was. If Lynn wants to retire, he will have to come to us; we are not going to him.

And father's attitude was similar, If the company wants me to retire, they will have to come to me; I am not going to them.

Finally, shortly after his 75th birthday, he told the company, "I think I will retire and go to live with my son, Daniel, in New Mexico."

The company officials said, "Well, that's fine, Lynn, but you have a job here with us as long as you want it."

"A Long Hard Trip"

The life of a geologist was enjoyable to father because he liked the out-of-doors and loved to walk. The rougher the country, the better he liked it.

When he was not feeling just right, he would say, "What I need is a long, hard trip." Then he would take a long walk and return smiling and feeling fine.

Father was thankful for his rugged health and all the good fortune of his life.

"Be Content if You Can"

Father remembered his parents talking of

an incident of his early life.

They were out at their farm near Denver talking of recent misfortunes — how a panic had taken their savings. They were at the table talking about their trouble and what they might do for the future.

Father, about age three, had been under the table, listening; and now he came up and said to his parents, "Be content if you can with the blessings you have.'

At this they both burst out laughing; and right away, things did not seem so bad after Father was reciting back some words that all his blessings bestowed upon us.

Throughout his career, father made lasting friends among all sorts and conditions of men." His school mate, Frank Bowman, in an article about father in Mines Magazine, said, "Lynn Storm was universally admired and liked; no one was ever known to dislike him."

Father was active in Saint Anne's Chapel, Glencoe, and was often a delegate to the Diocese Convention; and he was a true Christian gentleman.







P&Z to hear six requests today

Applicants will play to a tough room during the Ruidoso Planning and Zoning (P&Z) meeting Monday. The planning department has recommended denial for four of the six applicants scheduled for review.

Jack Dunlap's request for a
replat of Lots 7 and 8, Block 5, of
Glen Grove Subdivision gets planner Cleatus Richard's blessing to
cure an encroschment.

The village staff recommends denial for Edward Curtis Temple who wants to subdivide his Midtown property into two lots for the purpose of construction an additional business in an area now vacant.

Temple is the owner of the Broken Drum; a T-shirt shop in mid-town.

Planner Richards said the commission should deny Temple the replat because it would violate the zoning code by reducing parking below the required level, six spaces to three spaces. Richards said any new development proposed for the vacant lot could not meet parking requirements.

John R. Brown seeks a replat in the John R. Brown tract located on Gavilan Canyon. Brown wants to subdivide about 10 acres, all in excess of an acre.

Richards requests approval of the replat by the commission, writing that Gavilan Canyon Road is paved and adequate to serve the tracts proposed. He said Brown was dedicating right of way for Gavilan Canyon Road.

Village staff is recommending denial for Douglas Brown's request for a side yard variance for Lot 8, Block 1, White Mountain Estates.

Brown is requesting the variance to allow a 225 feet by 26 feet garage addition on the south side of his house to within 3.5 feet of the side property line.

Richards said the garage would encroach into a utility easement and that there were several alternatives which would not require a variance.

Village staff recommends denial of a front yard variance requested by Stacy Gude of Ponderosa Heights.

Richards said the property had been improved without permits and the proposed 8 x 18-foot addition

Jail tops talks of commission

A discussion about the expansion of the Lincoln County Jail and the sheriff's department is toward the bottom of the agenda of the County Commission meeting Tuesday.

But that item, a review of the proposed modifications to the county sub-office, a discussion of State Highway 214 and Airport Road D-004 and the preliminary budget hearing are three of the issues most directly affecting county residents.

The commission will meet at 9 a.m. in the county courthouse in Carrizozo.

Public hearings on the agenda include a proposed ordinance amending the county's antilitering law that would allow citations next to unoccupied dwellings; a proposed ordinance establishing a system of fees in reference to solid waste collection, including a late fee; and a proposed ordinance that would disband the county transportation board.

Commissioners have scheduled an executive session on personnel and pending litigation in the middle of their agenda.

Following that closed-to-thepublic session, appointments will be made by commissioners of representatives to the county planning

and zoning board.

The commission will consider the recommendations of the zoning board on several issues, including:

—a request by Harry Leonhardt to vacate a fire escape easement in Deer Park Woods subdivision Unit

—a request by Leo Villareal for a replat of lots 1,2,6,7,8,9,10 and 17 of Fox Run subdivision.

—a request by Robert Smith for a replat of Tract K of Eagle Creek subdivision and a replat of Lot 1, Block 1 of Pine Meadows subdivi-

sion.

—a request by Paul McClendon for a replet of Block B of Red Cedar subdivision.

would provide a frontage setback of 7.5 feet. The proposed addition is for bathroom expansion and a closet area.

Richards said the original house expansion has made expansion difficult and that Gude has not addressed a hardship, since lot size and topography are not a limiting factor, and conditions for granting a variance have not been met.

The conditional use requested by Alex Adams and granted on December 21, 1992, has come under scrutiny by the planning staff.

Richards said that Adams had submitted plans for placement of a HUD II mobile home on Lot 20, Block 1, Forest Heights Subdivision.

In January, Adams gained commission approval for placement of a

12 x 20-foot storage shed.

Richards said Adams cleared trees from the site, graded and

placed the storage shed, but not a residence on the property.

"It appears that Mr. Adams has not current plans to proceed with the development as approved," Richards wrote. "He may have, in fact, already accomplished his earlier started (sic) intention of clearing trees and grading with no plan of immediate development."

On April 28, Richards said Adams indicated that he did not intend to place the HUD II residence on the property.

Richards recommended the planning commission review previous approvals and rescind those approvals if Adams does not provide a specific schedule for development acceptable to the commission.

Richard said he felt Adams should remove the storage building and restore landscaping if previously approved development is not to be accomplished.

Images of Jesus

Showcases Imaginative Works of Art

For more than 20 centuries, many of the great religions of the world have strived, through art, music and literature, to capture the spirit of the man most commonly known in Western civilization as "Jesus." Images of Jesus, an hour-long documentary, explores the controversy, artistic achievement, and spiritual awakening surrounding the mystery of Jesus and their effects on artists throughout the world.

RESERVATION ROULETTE: INDIAN GAMING

Since the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act was passed by Congress in 1988, casinos have proliferated on Indian Reservations in fourteen states. In 1992, it is estimated that the Indian gaming industry revenues surpassed \$6 billion, making it larger than the \$5.7 billion Nevada gaming business. Casino profits are being invested in reservation infrastructure, including

housing, schools, health care centers, and cultural facilities. This program examines the legal and political conditions which led to the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act and the response by Native Americans and Nevada gaming groups.
