As the staff of Fort Stanton
Hospital gears up for the change that in the next few years tion in the next few years, some
wonder if old problems will be resolved with the shift in direction from developmentally disabled resi dents to long term care patients
During periods within the las two years, emplcyees who contacted The Ruidoso News contend that staffing levels dipped dangerously low, exposing both patients and em ployees to possible injury
One employee complained that atter reporting a possible case of at the fort in retaliation
Inequity in pay lack
Inequity in pay, lack of evalua existence of family-tie favoritism within the center also were amon concerns cited.

## Abuse procedures

Fort Stanton's record on abuse reports is good, said Steve Dossey, abilities Division of the State De partment of Health.
During the calendar year of 1992, only 13 reports were received through the various channels available. One report was substantiatud, ranged from as mild as someone shouting at a client to someon striking a client.

That park, Wingfield Park, has never been opened to the public, and it is now being offered for sale.

Wingfleld Park, purchased through a court settlement, includes a lovely fittle log cabln at the base of ment, includes a lovely ittle log cabin at the base of
Grindstone Lake. When it became village property it was In good shape, surrounded by beautiful lawns and trees with a creek running right by the house. It could easily have been opened as a party house and park to be used for picnics and family reunions and such. After spending more than $\$ 200,000$ to acquire this park, the village leadership at the time did nothIng. The cost to open this park to the public would have been next to nothing. Revenues for renting the cabin would have quickly covered the cost of any needed remodeling.

But it never happened, and this village - with an economy based on recreation and tourism - is now selling what could be a lovely little park. Selling Wingfield Park is a drepedful and short-sighted mistake.

This is a response to a recent let ter to the editor which I would like I was appalled by the let Dan D. Swearingin, The Ruidose News, Thursday, May 20. I was appalled by its tenor. I was appalled that people which I hold in high esteem had un called "petition."
