## Lobbying is lucrative for retired officials

Fomer elected officials are turning more and more to lobbying in their cetirement years: These people, whio are used to wielding power through their high offices, now translate that clout into big bucks as they lobby for all kinds of industries, issues and even foreign governments: It's a natlonal disgrace.

A good example of this power brokering is the North Amencan Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA). On May 20, The Wall Street Journal reported Mexico's annua spending to negotiate and sell NAFTA was $\$ 15,980,000$. Two former New Mexico governors are among the berieficiaries of all that foreign lobbying money. Governors Toney Anaya and Jerry Apodaca reportedily were paid $\$ 260,000$ and $\$ 170,000$ (respectively) last year. Unsuccessful congressional candidate Dan Sosa is a part of former governor Apodaca's labbying firm.

After representing U.S. taxpayers in various capacities, these political types seem to be changing their alleglance as they advocate for other countries We elected them, paid them, trained them and basi cally gave them the power and credibility that made them desirable as lobbyists. And now they're cashing in on our investment.

This practice may not be illegal, but it has at the very least the appearance of impropriety - we believe it is unethical.
