Medical Update on Breast Cancer
You may be hearing lots of facts and figures about breast cancer during the month of October, which is National Breast Cancer Awareness Month. Some of those facts are alarming; others are encouraging. Yet the
basic message for October is simple; breast cancer, when basic message for October is simple; breast cancer, when
detected early, can often be completely cured, and you can detected early, can often
help detect this disease.

The bad news about breast cancer is sobering. The incidence of breast cancer is going up, and scientists do not know exactly why. This year, 180,000 American women will develop cancer of the breast. Most will have
no known risk factor for the disease - meaning all women no known r
are at risk.

The good news is that, despite increasing incidence rates, the death rate from breast cancer has been fairly stable for many years. Improvements in early detection of breast cancer have been fairly stable for many years. Improvements in early detection of of breast cancer and in treatments for the disease help account for this trend. Also, earlier diagnosis now gives women more options for treatment: approximately 36 percent of women
develop breast cancer do not have a breast removed.

Early diagnosis is the key to treating breast cancer After treatment for early breast cancer, a woman's survival rate is as high as 90 percent. Every woman should take an active role in protecting her health by practicing monthly breast self-examination, having a yearly breast exam by a $p$
mammograms after age 40 .

Many women become so afraid of what they might find that they avoid examining their breasts. It is vitally important not to be ruled by fear. Even if you or you smait t one ifrive. fowever, if there is a problem, early detection not only improves your survival chances it may also improve your chances of avoiding a mastectomy.

There is some confusion over the statistic that "one in eight women" will develop breast cancer during their lifetime. This figure refers to women who live to age 90 at which time their chances of developing the disease jump to one in eight. The risk of breast cancer increases with age: at age 30, women have a one in 2,525 chance of developing the disease; at age 40 , a one in 217 chanc and at age 50 the rate jumps significantly to one in 50 .

Whatever your age, remember that taking care of your breasts is not something to be put off until tomorrow, but an essential and lifelong project.

# Ruidoso is seasoned just right for fall fun 

When the trees in the Hondo Valley start turning orange, yellow and brown, it's just a matter of time before Mother Nature splashes her magical golden paintbrush throughout the rest of Lincoln County.
Aspenfest is named for the stately mountain trees that grace the higher reaches - those trees are the stars of Ruidoso's annual fall festival.

But the big weekend owes its existence to the brilliant golden aspens.
Be sure and take a leisurely drive up the mountain and watch the aspens light up the forest.

From late September through early October the leaves of these tall trees turn a bright gold and as they fall they litter the ground with brightness, like a floor made of gold doubloons.
Aspens stand regally throughout the Lincoln National Forest - many within a few minutes drive of kuidoso.
Depending on your sense of adventure, these viewing areas can be reached via paved routes or by taking some of the forest roads in the vicinity.
The autumn change in leaves happens suddenly and lasts for just a brief time. Contrary to popular belief, the color change is not brought on by temperature changes or freezes, but by the lessening of the amount of sunlight during the autumn days.

If you need more information on trails or where to go in the forest lands, drop by the Smokey Bear Ranger District office on Mechem Drive in Ruidoso.

Aspenfest weekend, October $1-3$, is a festival that extends from oné end of town to the other.

A street dance kicks things off on Friday night, with a parade at 10 a.m. Saturday.

Q.I own a three-bedroom ranch home in a rural area. I have my own private well due to the unavailability of municipal water. Recently, I asked several of my neighbors if they have experienced any reduction in the performance of their wells. Unfortunately for me, I am the only homeowner who has had problems with low. water pressure and poor water quality. The well pump and water tank appear to be in operating condition. What could cause the above-mentioned irregularities in my system?
A. Initially speaking, a number of factors could be contributing to the disruptions in your well's performance. Some of these could be poor materials and/orconstruction, mineral deposits, and corrosion. However, there are also situations where the pumping equipment, instead of the well itself, is the culprit.
Taking into account what you've explained, it seems as if your system is doing its primary job, which is to pump water. Provided no other major problems, such as inadequate power or leaks, are concerned, there really isn't much else to troubleshoot. However, the possibility exists that your well's original capacity has been significantly reduced.

I would strongly suggest that you contact your local well contractbr about your problem and get a professional judgment. It is also wise to have yout well water tested annually to make sure it is safe to drink. In thost areas, the local health department will perform this test for free, They can also advise you as to their standards of safe drinking water, etc. Generally speaking, you must beware of the presence of coliforms and E-coli bacteria.

* You can now begin to shape up all of your lawn and garden equipment for next year's use
* Be sure to seal your blacktop driveways now before the cooler temperatures arrive.
* If you enjoyed the harvest of your vegetable garden this season, till-the soil for next year.
* It is always advisable to do all major work on your automobiles now, especially before winter.
* Give the exterior of your home a good visual inspection to see what priority maintenance needs to be performed. ***
