## Editorial

Get back to basics for safer schools

When violence takes center stage in public schools, it's time to double and then redouble efforts to provide students with basic skills - that means a return to the basics of reading, writing and arithmetic.

Some schools - faced with the reality of students toting guns to school and threatening teachers, administrators and each other - are responding with armed guards, metal detectors and part-time police officers spending time on campus. Yes, the schools have to take extreme measures to keep students and teachers safe, but those kinds of symptom-driven actions could be missing the point.
The truth is that a huge proportion of those who end up in jail cannot read. According to statistics provided by the U.S. Department of Education 85 percent of juvenile offenders have trouble reading and 60 percent of aduilt prison inmates are illiterate.
Gang members and violent teens profess a bravado and arrogance that belies the hopelessness and despair that comes through in their behavior. And, what more hopeless feeling than to look into a future where you're unable to compete in a highly-technical
world. Just learning how to read will provide a foundation for stepping bravely into that world without a gun and without the security of wearing a gang's colors.
"The bottom line is that our schools need to teach youngsters all the skills they need to participate effec tively and honestly in our society," reads information providad by Applied Schalastios, an organization dedicatad to improving the quality of education using philosophies borrowed from author L. Ron Hubbard. The groùp concentrates on tutoring juvenile offenders, and has statistics to show the successes they've recorded with Jailed youths. Applled Scholastics suggests that the same methods used in jails would work In schools to improve educational levels and reduce violence and crime among children who have not yet gone over the edge.
"Forget increasing the number of armed guards in schools," reads information provided by Applied Scholastics. "Let's get education back on track instead."
