contained in the accountability report detail the percentage of tenth graders who pass the test the first time compared to the rest of the state.
For the past three years, Ruidoso has kept ahead of the stat points. dents statewide passed all subtests in the examination, while 81.4 percent passed in Ruidoso. The next
year, the gap narrowed with 76 per year, the gap narrowed with 76 per-
cent and 77.1 percent. But in 1992 93, Ruidoso tenth graders not only recaptured their lead, but also gained by more than 10 points from
their scores two years earlier with y1.4 percent passing compared to 84.1 percent statewide. The subtests cover reading, lanstudies and composition.
Ruidoso students taking the
ACT college entrance examination have never scored on a par with na tional averages. Only in $1989-90$,
out of three years of testing, did they score higher than state aver ages. But they wer
any of those years.
any of those years.
In 1989-90, the mean composite score for district students taking the ACT was 20.4 compared to the state at 20.1 and the nation at 20.6 .
In 1990-91, the district score was 19.9 compared to the state at 20.1 and the nation at 20.6 ; and in compared to 20.0 for the state and 20.6 for the nation's students "It's very comparable," Wirth
