## Lawmakers' motto:

## spend now, save later

Some state lawmakers are scrambling for an excuse to keep that six-cent gasoline tax that took effect July 1. Turns out the state didn't really NEED the new tax, which will bring about $\$ 50$ milllon into the general tax, which wim bring about $\$ 8$ millon to road construction.
fund

Why give back a tax increase that's already been enacted? After all, state government desperately needs money in some areas - like Social Services. That money could be used by Health and Human Services for a wide range of programs, such as child care, abuse prevention, nutrition, substance abuse treatment, domestic violence shelters and family counseling. Sounds good. An Albuquerque lawmaker said: "If we catch a lot of problems wẹ have ... we'll save money in the future."
But, the way the state spends money, it's doubtful any of that money would ever reach the state's needy people who need those services. Humian Services is often in a money crunch, and it's no wonder. It's the agency that just entered into a lease for a brand new building here in Ruidoso. With state funds, to help the poorest of the poor, Human Services budgeted to increase its annual rent from the current level of $\$ 13,000$ to $\$ 37,800$; then: requested proposals for a building, turned down the lower bid and opted for a buliding, turned down the lewer bad and
10 -year lease that will cost taxpayers $\$ 700,000$. Immediately, when Human Services moves from the Stroud Building into its brand new building, the rent will go from $\$ 13,000$ to $\$ 61,000$. It takes some pretty deep pockets to triple office rent, and then go over budget by almost half again. It's going to take a lot of gasoline tax to make up that increase in renti
State officials in Ruidoso a few weeks ago were proud of their record of renegotiating hundreds of state leases. All the leases that were revipwed by a
 reporter showed big increases in cosis hit taxpayers are taking here in Ruidoso may be only the tip of the leaberg.

So, when elected officials claim they're taking this new tax to HELP the needy of this state, it's beyond belief. It may be time for "New Mexico Proposition Six" as the voters way of persuading state lawmakers to give back that six-cent tax
