After that job, she headed back to California, first to become chief of Indian health services and later
to join the Department of Education.
"I retired from there seven years ago and have been doing consulting and training," Sample said.
When Head Start began in the 1960s, it took several years to see any measurable results in the children who later attended regular school, Sample said.
"The people weren't trained, although it was one of the best

## Wild turkeys nearly disappeared in the U.S

Most people celebrated Thanksgiving this year with a traditional turkey dinner, much like the Pilgrims did years ago

Today, turkeys are farm raised and specialy grown to produce more white meat and bigwild turkeys and were a symbol of the bounty provided by nature in the "New World."
Oddly enough though, this symbal of plenty, the wild turkey, almost disappeared from the continent within a couple of centuries.
The wild turkey originally ranged throughout almost all regions of the North American continent. It was noted for its intelligence and
hardiness. As a matter of fact, the wild turkey hardiness. As a matter of fact, the wild turkey was favored over the baid eagle by
Even though the wild turkey is a hardy bird, they had a difficult time competing with advancing civilization. They were dependent upon hardwood forests and as pioneer settlers advanced across the country these forests were cleared by farmers to grow crops and cut down
by loggers to guild cities. This, combined with hungry pioneers shooting them for food By 1813 , turkege decline in wild turkeys. By 1813, turkeys no longer existed in Conand from Iowa by 1907. In the 1930s their and from lowa by 1907. In the 1930s their numbers were so low that the future of the North America.
Something had to be done to save these magnificent birds.
Of course, wild turkeys were given protection by law, but that wasn't enough. Some serious restoration and management programs were required.
A big leap forward was made when biologists developed a method of capturing entire flocks of wild turkeys and
Studies wore cable habita
Studies were conducted on turkeys to find help them.
Here in New Mexico research carried out by the Department of Game and Fish has led to recommended changes in land management practices that enhance areas for wild turkeys.
Simple things such as leaving some slash piles
around after a logging operation to proviru better nesting areas and making small cléarngs when logging to provide feeding areasito young bird
The d
The department also continues to trap \&ifl wid turkeys to new locations.
Since its inception in 1937, this act h $\mathrm{R}_{\mathrm{K}}^{\mathrm{g}}$ resulted in about $\$ 1.5$ billion being distributefi grams, hunter education management preacquisition. The management programs patid for by P-R funds have not only helped what turkeys but also many other wildlife species including elk, pronghorn antelope and mule deer.
As for the turkeys, in less than 50 years restocking and management programs have restored them to healthy numbers in 45 states. In fact wild turkeyse nore now hlacyer

Now, instead of just being a part of history vild turkeys are abundant. Oirs and future generations should give thanks that we coly see this magnificent bird, once again, roami in the wilds.

New Mexicans more likely to die from injuries

Although New Mexico is one of the states with the highest rates of injuries in the nation, lincoln end of the injury range
Information about the state and its counties was contained in a report compiled from 1991 by the New Mexico Department of Health's Injury Control Section.
ldentified as the three leading causes of ceaths in New Mexico
were diseases of the heart, malig nant neoplasms and unintentional injuries.
Injuries are the leading cause of death and disability for all New Mexicans under the age of 44.
The purpose of the report was to document the magnitude of New Mexico's injury problem, but it identified serious lapses and fragmentation of injury death and dis ability data.
Tieg lack of data on non-fatal injuries prevented New Mexico from eral grant, according to Carolyn Hutchinson, spokesman for the department.

Injury fatalities are well docu mented in New Mexico," she said "However, fatalities are just the tip of the iceberg.
"It is estimated that there are 16
njury-caused hospitalizations for every injury-related death, resulting in a cost to sociaty of more than of noilion annually. The number or non-fatal injuries and resulting permanent disabilities is not well documented in the state. Until data an nonfatal injuries is available, jury problem remains Mexico's in ury problem remains unknown." the report, New Marts contained in Georgia are the only three states in the nation that fall into states in category of 76 to 97 injury death per 100,000 population.
The states with the lowest in cidence, 35 to 45.9 per 100,000 , were clustered in the northeast around the Great Lakes region and North Dakota.
In New Mexico, Lincoln County ared poorly in deaths from motor vehicle crashes, falling into the second highest category of 40-59 deaths per 100,000 population,
along with the counties of San Juan, Rio Arriba, McKinley Sandoval, Quay Torrance Socorro and Luna.
Those counties registered more deaths by vehicle accidents per 100,000 than the high traffic counties of Bernalillo and Santa Fe which fell in the $20-39$ per $\mathbf{1 0 0 , 0 0 0}$ range. The three worst counties, with 60-199 per 100,000, were Cibola, Catron and Sierra.

But two years ago, Lincoln County reported no homicides, as did the eight other counties of Union, Harding, Mora, Torrance, DeBaca, Eddy, Hidalgo and Catron. Santa Fe and Bernalillo were included in the 1-19 homicides per 100,000 . The counties with the highest rate of more than 29 were Rio Arriba and Sierra.
In suicides, Lincoln fell into the same category as Santa Fe, Bernalilo and 10 other counties
with 1-19 deaths per 100,000 . The with $1-19$ deaths per 100,000 . The
two counties with the highest rate of more than 39 were Sierra and Catron.
Lincoln shifted into the higher classification of 40-79 deaths per 100;000 under the "other injury" comparison. That was higher than Santa Fe and Bernalillo, which were in the $20-39$ range, but in the same grouping as the counties of McKinley, Colfax, Mora, San The Torrance, Quay and Sierra. atal injuries concerned motor vehicle accidents.
In that comparison, Lincoln County fell into the highest grouping with 1,231 to 2,222 injuries per 100,000 population, along with Hidalgo, Torrance Guadalupe and Union
The counties of Santa Fe and Bernalillo were significantly lower in the 531-870 per 100,000 range.

## Look for experienced candidates who care about the community

'Who will run for village offices next March?' is the question being bandied about in coffee rooms all over the village these days. It's good that voters and prospective candidates are putting some thought into a serious question.

In Ruidoso, the mayor, municipal judge and four council slots will be on the ballot next March, but candidates will sign up in early January. The council positions that will be up for grabs are currently filled by Barbara Duff, Bill Karn, Joe Gomez and Frank Potter. Three of the terms will be for four years and one for two years.

Village, as well as county, residents have learned from experience that electing (or appointing) an inexperienced newcomer to a position of leadership is very dangerous. It's been shown that the most effective elected officials are the ones who already demonstrated their civic and community spirit by fulfilling appointed and/or volunteer positions.
So, when looking for candidates for mayor, council and municipal judge, we'd suggest looking first to people who already have served: were they honest and reliable? did they do a good job?

Next, we'll be turning our attention to people who have served on P\&Z, the Lodgers Tax Advisory Board, the school board, county commission and other groups that deliberate and make decisions: were they deperietabie and fair? dild they understand the scope of their responsibilities?

The candidates we won't be supporting, and the ones we hope won't even toss their hats in the ring, are the "one-issue" or "vendetta" candidates who tear down rather than build up and seek public office to ful fill some personal agenda.

Let's find people to lead our town who put the interests of the community first.

## Don't count on relief from 6-cent gas tax

Along with the weather, the prospects of a rollback of that six-cent-a-gallon gasoline ta passed at, the last Legislatture haye chillein in the case if the sentiments of key legislators responsible for developing state tax policy are any barometer.
Just three months ago the drumbeat for repeal was loud enough to disturb the political peace in every corner of the state. Some top state Republicans, sensing an opportunity to capitalize anew on their familiar anti-tax dogma, even demanded that the governor cal a special session of the Legislature for that purpose.
Governor Bruce King prudently rejected that idea. Nevertheless, always sensitive to the roiling winds of tax politics, King promised After all, he pointed out, the gas levy was ap proved by lawmakers to cover a budget short fall which never materialized and something should be done to rectify the situation.
More than likely something will be done. But, according to state Representative Jerry Sandel (D-San Juan) relief may not mean axing the gas tax.
Sandel is chairman of the Legislature's awkwardly-named Interim Joint Revenue Stabilization and Tax Policy Committee which is studying ways to reduce state taxes by as much as $\$ 50$ million next year. That's roughly what the six-cent gas tax brings in, he notes. The problem with "just cutting the (gas) make certain it will ever get back to the taxpayers ... Even petroleum markets have told

the committee that they won't guarantee that the price (of gas) at the pump will go down if we eliminate the tax.
That news, alone, ought to be unsettling to a lot of New Mexicans. Petroleum marketers were quick enough to pass the six-cent tax in effect last summer. Yet, when the question is put to them today, they apparently won't promise to let us return the favor by passing it back to them if the tax is cut.
Even Solomon would have difficulty detect

with the taxpayers ... We're looking at a

Ryan says he personally favors a one-time personal income tax rebate.
"To do much more at this time might not be wise in view of the uncertainty of the economy ," he insists.
Given the responsibilities vested by the Legislature in its Revenue Stabilization and Tax Policy Committee, the sentiments of rank ing committee members like Sandel and Ryan ahould carry more than a little weight when awmakers meet in January

Which is not to say there won't be efforts by tax. There almost certainly will be. The op portunities for political grandstanding on an issue as tempting as this are simply too attrac tive to be ignored by your run-of-the-mill legislative politico.
Nevertheless, when a pair of lawmakers as avvy on the issue of tax policy as Democrat Jerry Sandel and Republican Murray Ryan say cutting the gas tax will almost certainly not add up to relief for the taxpayer,
