If people who intend to bring us their pups. would just get their shots irst, it could save their lives, said office manager Kathy Tetreault. It takes two weeks for the first shot to take effect. Even then, it's not a guarantee. Pups need their whole series of shots to have the best chance at survival. It is an absolute necessity that adopted to a veterinarian within the first week for their free exam ination, their rabies shot or for ination, their rabies shot or for
their Parvo-Corona-distemper im munization series. Without the full series, animals are not protected. Because shelter workers don' know whether strays are carrying diseases or have been given shots they do their best to keep pupe isolated. But until the shelter is expanded next spring and more spac Foster homes can help by provid
aster homes can help by provid
the first few weeks.
But the only real answer is owner responsibility, through spay ing and neutering to eliminate unwanted litters, by not allowing animals to run loose, and through proper medical care and immunizations.
It's taxpayers and humane supporters who bear the financial bur den for pet owners who fail to neuter their animals and then refuse to care for the resulting litters of pups and kittens.

Ruidoso's mandatory spay and neuter law and leash ordinance allow village officials to levy heavy erly restrain their animals or allow them to reproduce and then do not
provide a home for the offspring.
State law now also requires animals adopted from shelters to be spayed or neutered.
More than 8 -million pets a year are killed in shelters and municipal pounds across the nation. The only humane solution is to limit reproduction, not to destroy milions of wonderful companions. Someone out there is missing a chance pot named Moments a smiling, friendly Australian shepherd mix, whose coat is curly and soft.

The shelter also is home to shepherds, border collies, chows, a neutered collie, golden retrievers, black labradors, a sharpei and terier mixes.

"Federal funding for the Southwest Region, when compared to funds allocated to other Forest Service Regions, is grossly inequitable," Skeen wrote, noting that the Southwest Region, which in cludes New Mexico, contains 21 million acres compared to 24 million acres in the service's Northwest Region. Yet the Northwest Region has almost twice the funds ( $\$ 95.2$-million) to manage non-timber related resources than does the Southwest Region ( $\$ 56.3$-million) in fiscal year 1993.

## Editorial

## Start the year safely

Santa has come and gone, the gifts are all opened, Christmas dinner is over, but the festivities and travel continue. Everyone is driving to and from New Year's parties, or returning from the homes of friends and relatives. This is the time of year that we must be especially careful while in our motor vehicles.

Everyone on the highways must be on the lookout for those who ignore all warnings and common sense, and insist on driving while under the influence of drugs - mainly alcohol. Each year thousands of people are killed or maimed in traffic accidents, many of which involve drugs - mainly alcohol.
In 1991, 261 people died in alcohol-related traffic crashes in New Mexico An alcohol involved crash occurred every 106 minutes. One person was injured in an alcohol-involved crash every two hours.

There are several things we can do to reduce the carnage on the highways. You've heard them all but it doesn't hurt to remind ourselves during the holiday season. If you are hosting a party be especially careful not to let your guests imbibe to extreme. Have nonalcoholic beverages and plenty of food available. If someone seems too intoxicated to drive, offer to drive them home. If your guests to not want a ride - insist! It's better to make them mad for a while than to allow them to drive and possibly get killed or kill someone else. Don't just think this advice is for others - you are a human being, too, and are not immune to the effects of alcohol

This takes care of looking out for ourselves and our friends who drink, but how can we protect ourselves from others who for whatever reasons will hot heed the warnings? The number one way we can protect ourselves is to remember to buckle our safety belts and put our kids in child restrain devices. Then if we do happen to "meet" one of those intoxicated drivers via an accident, we will have a better chance to come out alive and uninjured. We owe it to ourselves and our loved ones to do everything possible to make traveling safe.

## Will McKean try for another term?

The governor's office hasn't officially announced if the chief executive will run again,
but chances are that he will. So we have to but chances are that he will. So we have to start asking ourselves: Do we want John McKean in office for another term or not?
McKean isn't really the governor, of course, but sometimes it seems as though he is. More and more, newspaper readers see the name of Bruce King's press secretary in stories that say that "McKean commented..." or "McKean said the governor

Clearly, King has found a way of communicating with the media without actually talking all that much to its members.
Bruce fe fair, if a reporter wants to talk to bruce King he or she can. The media is being kept at arm's length, but it isn't being stiffed. Still, when King was governor from 1971 to more accessible to the media than he is today He is more isolated now than he was then. He had press secretaries, but none had quite the authority to speak for King that McKean does.
Early this month, for example, a newspaper story about taxes noted that spokesman, John McKean, said that in addispokesman, John McKean, said that in addi-
tion to the gas tax appeal, the governor also tion to the gas tax appeal, the governor also
would like to see low income tax rebates cut back by the legislature last year restored. back by the legislature last year restored. cerned about extending tax relief to the working poor - those with incomes who do no
qualify for food stamps, Medicaid, or other state or federal assistance. "The poor were hit
 the second time with the gas tax,' McKean said. 'The governor thinks that whenever we do, we ought to target these people."'
A recent story on the governor's pardon of John Bishop, the former Ross Perot campaign official who had an old drug conviction on his record, had this quote from McKean: "It seems it would have been questionable if we hadn't pardoned him, McKean said. We don't
a political advantage or disadvantage.

McKean's face - not his boss's
made it into a political cartoon about the prob lem of finding a place for the homeless in Albuquerque.
Chances are that reporters who quoted McKean didn't have to wait for him to ask his boss what to say. McKean is so in tune with King's thinking that more often than not, he can answer questions right off the bat.
Who is this high-profile press secretary? for 20 years McKean, now 46, was in the news
business himself, and he has been the news
director for both KOAT and the old KGGM television stations.
When he began working on King's campaign for a third term, McKean figured he'd probably stop working for King when the election was over. But, he recalled, "I had a lot better time than I thought I would.

Now he talks about next year's campaign, when King plans to try for another term in of-
fice. fice.
Sometimes, McKean can act as a lightning can send a message - to the Legislature, say - on behalf of his boss, without his boss having his name attached personally to the message. An able New Mexico press secretary is worth his weight in water.
McKean's background in news also gives him an instinct for the peculiar needs of news people. One of these needs is for something to say on any public issue.
No excuses are accepted by the media, which generally believes that the state conly for the benefit of the media.
King understands the
King understands the media's needs, according to McKean. The governor hates to see fice was available for comment," McKean remarked.

With McKean in office, King doesn't have to worry much that a sentence like that will find its way into the papers.
