and Rescue, said Galvan was found on the trail to the Great Western Mine in the Bonito area of the forest, about three miles from the unit's base camp.

He decided to talk a walk with his brother-in-law and sister bout 11 a.m., but they soon tired and returned to camp. own. His family reported him miss ing by midafternoon, but search teams were not called until about 6
p.m. White Mountain was on the scene within 30 minutes, establishsearch toamp, Headley said. She Patrol, the canine team B.A.R.K. from Thjeras, search and rescue Chaves County, for a total of about 60 searchers.
"What we discovered was that he must have crisscrossed the trails several times," Headley said. "He thought he had gone so far, but
then he saw a footprint that looked like his own and it was.
"He climbed a cliff thinking he could see the camp, but he saw
things that were totally unfamiliar. things that were totally unfamiliar. Through all of this, he said he never was particularly worried."

The sturdy weed with prickly thorns can grow to seven feet in height and grves off a pleasan wrome out a pasture Each plant ca wipe out a pasture. Each plant pro90 percent germinate in the fir two years.
"But they also can remain dormant for up to 10 years, even sprout," said Greg Gray with the U.S. Forest Service, Smokey Bear District.
Plants are considered noxious, because they are harmful to other plants or animals and they replace aative plants.
Generally, they were introduced by accident into the United States ornamental plant and then spread nto the forests and rangelands. They are prolific reproducers and spread rapidly, transported by Unsugpecting, admirers who
Unies, Unsuspecting admirers who put spread their seeds. Even livestock owners may contribute when seeds are mixed in with feed.

The state Legislature has been generous with the Ruto oso irepucve the past thire spsslons, revalizing Midown throigh the Mainstreet project, funding the Rutidese coblvention ceinter and scheduling Highway 48 ír a miafor reconstruction.

Ruidoso and the surrounding area will benefit from $\$ 92$ milion in severrance tax bonds sold last week by the New Mexico State Board of Finance to pay for 320 projpets around the state:

Projects in Lincoln County that will be financed with the proceeds include the Ruidoso Water Treatment Plant at Grindstone for $\$ 570,000$, Foit Stanton Hospital免conversion to a long-term nursing faelity was allogated \$268,000 and \$193,000, Glencoe's multipurpose center (Senior Citizens Center) was funded for $\$ 150,000$, a sidewalk project in the settiement of Lincolin for $\$ 5,000$, compliance with the Americans. with Disabilities Act for the swimming pool in Carrizozo for $\$ 5,000$, the police/court complex in Carrizozo for $\$ 3,500$, and Ruidoso Downs Village Hall for $\$ 20,000$.

Furiding for those needed projects adds up to $\$ 1.2$ million in state funds that will be spent in Lincoln County. The county benefits twice, first with the needed facilities and second as the money is spent for salaries and supplies boosting the area economy.
