## Editorial

## Elections bogged down by confusion

New Mexico's Supreme Court stod firmly in favor of andopen ballot in its decision Thursday to allow the Green Party siate on the November ballot. In a 4-todecision, the court agreed with Secretary of State Stephanie Gonzales that gubernatorial candidate Roberto Mondragon and the entire Green slate have a right to be on the ballot.

White the Green Party may well have been playing polltics by sitting back and waiting to see who won the Democratic and Republican parties' nominations, the court agreed that doesn't mean its candidates can't join in the race after the primaries.

Challengers to allowing the Greens on the ballo contend that a state law requires party members to be registered as Greens by the date of the election prociamation, January 31. None of the Green candidates registered as Greens until after the June 7 primary.

Assistant Attorney General Robert Booms contends that the election code is structured so that minor parties can wait and'see, but the candidates who fol low the system by going through the primary system say it's not fair to have "sour grapes" candidates jump in at the last minute.

Open access to the ballot is a concept that is hard to fault, but election laws are drafted to provide some framework and order for the process of selecting lead ers at evers level. Even the Greens would agree that therés a point of no return when it is just too tate to be added to a ballot; but, on the other hand even the Democrats and Republicans would admit that we have a multi-party system, not just a two-party one That means those minor parties, which don't neces sarily need to conduct a primary, do need a simple process to join in the general election ballot. That process needs to be simple.

Attorneys on both sides agree that the election code is confusing. Legislators should take a close look at this whole scenario with a view toward simplifying the election code before the next general election.

Is there a way to curb the costs of modern political campaigns? There have been all kinds of proposals to do something about it - everything short of burning political action committees at the stake.
Little has come of those proposals, of
course, although some see President course, although some see President Clinton's campaign reform initiatives as a step in the right direction.
Still vast and unseemily sums of moniey are laid out every election year as candidates scramble to devise ever more effective (and ever more expensive) high profile media costly consultants.
Democrat Bruce King dropped more than a half million dollars in his bid for renomination at the June 7 primary. Gary Johnson doled out nearly as much in his quest for the Republican
gubernatorial nomination. This on top of the humdreds of thousiands of dopleirs drained from the campaign gitties of rumner-up would-bs governoxs like Dertiontait Casey Luine and $\mathrm{Re}_{\mathrm{e}}$
publicaị Dick Cheney. Memillan spent a big wad to pulli of an easy primary, victory. Evein U.S. Senator: Jeff Bingamia, tho had, no opposition for renomindation by the Demiocrats, thought it prudent th up his visibility with a wall hitone put harigy inexpensive seties of pre-printary I No coubt all thíe moveg creatuad jobs and sept sotme peopte worthoge critics of the cur
