## Hunters, drought reduce local bear numbers

If you're not seeing as many bears this year, there may be
several reasons why, said Brian several reasons why, said Brian
Gleadle, area game manager for the Gleadle, area game manager for the New Mexico Game and Fish Divi-
sion.
"I would say the population has been lowered considerable from what it was last year," which was a nuisance bears around Ruidoso

Gleadle said. No overall population estimate is available, because the agency does not count black bears, he said.
The fall hunt was partially responsible for reducing the number of bears around Ruidoso, he said. The bears were more accessible to hunters as they moved down into and near the town. Hunters legally killed and Ruidoso area (including the White

Mountain Wilderness and the Bonito, Hale and Grindstone lake areas). Five additional kills were related to illegal activity, three died after being hit by cars and 13 bear were tranquilized and relocated, Gleadle said.
"That means a total of 57 bears actually were removed from that population," Gleadle said

The number hunted and killed only 24 , but Gleadle didn't has

Trive. pays $60 \%$ of road improvement costs under the program, said Alan

However, the project's scope may be reduced, because of the shortage of money, Briley said.
The village wanted to do 153,000 worth of improvements.

fiscal year. Major road improvements are planned for 26 other gtreets; they will be paved or
regraveled. In fact, the city budget
provides for some form of road im provement to all 136 miles reets in Ruidoso, Briley said. The co-op funds actually represent a small portion of the vi
lage's proposed $1995-96$ street de partment budget of $\$ 1.2$ million.

Work on the state/village road program for 1994-95 will likely take place this summer, Briley said Streets identififed for repaving in this $\$ 109,000$ list are Center, E Paso, Rio, Grindstone, Chase, Fern,

## Solid Waste Authority plans to close Capitan landfill in one year

Residents along the Capitan andfill road shouldn't have any reason to complain about blowing debris and tire-tearing nails in about 12 months.
The Lineoln County Solid Waste Authority, which operates the construction debris landfill, took steps last w
Members, who represent the county and its five municipalities, to begin the procedure with the deadine date of July I, 1996. Lewandowski recommended the move, reminding the board they planned to close in two years anyway to avoid financial as-
surance requirements that would
be imposed in April 1997. The new do," Lewandowski said. "We can't federal requirements make the annancial operators post significant ure costs of cloing to ensure that futhe landfills will be cond monitoring To close in a year, information will be gathered and sent to the state Environment Department for pproval. A dumping convenience gtation must be created and a tub
grinder, capable of grinding up construction debris and other pieces too large for a chipper, must be purchased, Lewandowski said.
The situation will be similar to the arrangement at the county seat Carrizozo, which has used a convenience station without incident since its landfill closed several years ago.
"There's a whole lot of things to
do," Lewandowski said. "We can't have to close scon anywe going to mess around?'
Tires and pine needles can be stored at the site until the authority finds a use for them, because the group will own the ground even if the landfill is closed, he said. Most of the discarded large appliances already are recycled, he
said. said.
Capitan easily can live without the Capitan landfill," Lewandowski concluded.
While the landfill has been open, neighbors have complained that nails dropped from trucks heading to and from the landfill have caused dozens of flats a year and ruined tires.

Dear Mis. Wilson:
It truly is an honor to be writing to you and we are certain that you
can be of help to us.
We have lived in Ruidoso for al most 25 years, raised four children hers, been in business for our and Christian School systems, as well as starting the Montessori Prechool 13 years ago.
At that time, we saw our community's need for a quality preschool program accommodating dargarten who could not attend kin dargarten. Wereditation from the Rocky Mountain Montassori Theacher Training Progream in Boalder, Colorado, and the American Montessori Society.
We wers disturbed and shocked when Mr. Charles Patrick and two of his associates appeared one day last November informing us that since we "cared for" children undor the age of five years, wo were not pected to comply to and ChildrenCuth, and Family Licensing businems.
We tried to explain that we were
not a child care facility. Neither Mr Patrick or his associates were inter ested in learning anything about the Montessori method and/or phi losophy. We thought it best to have a parent meeting informing every one as to what was going on. We have had to obtain an at corney and have met with our state representative, Mr. Dub Williams. Dub has known us for many years.
He knows our educational backHe knows our educational backdrounds, has taught our own children, realizes our values and stan-
dard of living, and knows many of the more than 200 youngsters we have worked' with in Montessor over the years. He recently visited our school (now closed for the sum mer months), and agrees with us that something MUST be done to koep our facility open until the appropriate action can be taken by you or the New Mexico State Legisand unreasonable Children, Youth and Families regulation pertaining o private schools and age restrictions.

## "Expedition Inspiration"

Five years ago, Laura Evans of Sun Valley, Idaho, was diagnosed with rapidly advancing breast cancer. Evans was told she had a fifteen percent chance of surviving the disease. Despite several different treatments, including a bone marrow transplant as primary therapy, the disease almost killed her - but no quite. In January of 1995, Evans went on to lead sixteen other breast cancer survivors on the second biggest challenge of their lives - to climb the highest mountain in the Westem Hemisphere.
The New Explorers joins these brave women for every step of their $\mathbf{2 2 , 8 3 4}$ foot journey in "Expedition Inspiration.
With the help of internationally-known mountaineer, Peter Whittaker, Laura Evans decided to give other breast cancer survivors the sense of achievement and empowerment that challenging a mountain like Anconcagua could instill.

Based on each individual's mountaineering experience, the team is divided into two groups. Six breast cancer survivors attempt the summit while the remaining eleven follow in support of their teammates to base camp at 14,000 feet. The New Explorers follows every rugged step of the climb, as rivers and gorges are crossed, and vast mountainscapes challenge each woman to achieve her personal goal in much the same way she confronted cancer.

Along the way, "Expedition Inspiration" looks at the epidemic of breast cancer, a disease that will attack one in eight Amertcan women. As the women progress along the steep trail, several are turned back by the extremes of the high altitude environment. But through it all, "Expedition Inspiration" is a tale of hope - a story of seventeen strong women who, having looked unflinchingly at the face of death, have empowered themselves for new, previously uncontemplated challenges. The jourmey is more than a mountain climb. It is an inspiration for all who suffer - or will suffer - a life-threatening disease. ## POOP SCOOP

by DIANNE STALLINGS Ruidoso News Staff Writer National Dog Bite Pre vention Week was observed last month. Unfortunately, it's not a high profile event even. though more than two million dog bites are reported each year in the United Statees.

Letter carriers account for 2,700 of those bitten.
In Ruidoso, if a dog or more exotic pet is picked up because it has bitten someone, the owner faces some expensive options and tough decisions.
Depending on the circumstances and judgment of the village impounding officer, the animal is quarantined in the owner's home or at the Lincoln County Humane Society's animal shelter.

The charge for quarantine at the shelter is $\$ 5$ per day if the animal is taken from the home. However, if it was running loose, a $\$ 25$ impound fee also is charged.
"Whether the animal has its rabies shots or not, it must be quarantined," said Ruidoso Animal Control Officer Peggy Williams. "No vaccine is $100 \%$ certain. But if it has shots and is not in any violation of the law, the control officer will opt to allow home quarantine. That -means the owner pays nothing, except any civil liability from the bite incident itself."

At the enid of the 10-day quarantine period and before an animal is released from the shelter, it must be brought into
compliance with village and state laws. It must have a city license if its home is within the city limits, it must have rabies shots, and it must be neutered if it is more than six months of age.
Most wild animals that are kept as pets, such as raccoons, foxes and even wolf hybrids, would have to be destroyed immediately if they have bitten someone, because no rabies vaccine has been approved as effective for them, Williams said.
An approved vaccine now is available for ferrets, she said. "Lots of times the owners will release the dogs to us to be destroyed," said Sandra Ford, assistant director of the shelter.
That's a tragic end for a pet who may have just been protecting his home and family.
The Humane Society of the United States put out tips on how to avoid being bitten. The society advised:

- don't run past a dog. The dog's natural instinct is to chase and catch prey.
- if a dog threatens you, don't scream. Avoid eye contact, try to remain motionless until the dog leaves, then back away slowly until the dog is out of sight.
- don't approach a strange dog, especially one that's tied or confined.
- always let a dog gee and sniff you before attempting to pet it.
