## Ruidoso councilors hear another request for obscenity ordinance

by KATHLEEN MCDONALD Ruidoso News Staff Writer
As Ruidoso councilors gather Tuesday to hear a legal report on obscenity laws, they'll also hear a local homemaker.
Dora LaBrecque says she decided to draft a law after the obscenity issue was last brought before the councilors Oct. 31.
"It looked like nothing was going to happen," LaBrecque said Friday. I thought Pd see what I could do to push an ordinance through.
Her proposal puts a different spin on pablic obscenity. It refers to the public display of explicit serual According to state law, municipalities may define and
abate public nuisances and impore penalties.
LaBrecque's ordinance defines erual material obscene matter and obscene displays. It proposes village officials seize the public nuisance material if the violator Cails to promptly remove it, and recommends maximum penalties of Sand 90 days in the county jail. LaBrecque said her proposal would prevent public, outdoor displays of sexually explicit art like the statue carved by Ruidoso artist Candyce Gartett outride her Sud"When I first saw the Garrett When I first saw the Garrett Dtatue digplayed on Sudderth Drive," LaBrecque wrote the com
cilors, "my jait fall to the floor"" The etatue, which is no long
here, depicted a couple locked horizontally in a sensuous embrace. It prompted area residents in October to request a minimum standard of decency law.
Dennis Johnston, who co-filed a citizen's criminal complaint against Garrett in Octoher over her art is now helping LaBrecque in her pursuit of an ordinance. Johnston's complaint was dismissed in late Oc tober by the Ruidoso Magistrate Court after District Attorney Bert Atkins said it had no basis in law. About the same time, the village council put off further consideration of an obscenity ordinance until its attorneys researched similar ordinances.

## Elks reluctantly disconnect video gaming machines

by Kathleen mcdonald Ruidoso Nows Stafl Writer Electronic gaming machines tucked in the side room of the Ruidk source of scholarship the charity money for many Lincoln County residents.
But the Elks say the machines have been removed to storage, un plugged because the state supreme court ruled two weeks ago they were illegal.
Their removal precedes a sweep of Lincoln County's fraternal and charity organizations this week by the Department of Public Safety's special investigations bureau, deputy secretary Robert Perry said checked out Albuquerque-area checked
clubs.
It's unfair, says Bobby Caudle, the local Elks' Exalted Ruler. The lodge never questioned its need to comply with the law, he said - but abiding by it doesn't make the Supreme Court ruling any more palatable.
"The Indians still have their machines going, but any charity organization - which donates all that money to charity - can't keep their machines going," Caudle com plained.
His voice grew louder inside the dimly-lit Elks Lodge lounge, where Esquibel.

The 266 lodge members donate about $\$ 60,000$ annually to cerebral palsy programs, college scholarCaudle said. They also support other charitable needs, like a voice computer they bought last year to enabled a severely disabled woman to speak after a serious accident just a couple of days after her wedding), or the shelter provided last week for a Ruidoso man left homeless.
"We need ir never ignored a person in need if we can assist," Esquibel said. A good half of that charity money came from the lodge's elec-
tronic poker machines, Caudle said. They'd been in the fraternal club or at least eight years, probably longer, he said.
Other funds come from the lodge's "fish night," rental of the lodge for special events, Bingo night (which is scheduled to start again in January), and other fund raisers.
Esquibel, a Ruidoso police detec tive, described the state court ruling as "very disheartening.

Keep that chimney clean for Santa - and for your own protection

When the Ruldoso Downs mayor was recently called out of a council meeting because the chimney on his house ceuight tire, it brought home a common problem.
As the woodburning season gets underway, homeowners need to think about chimney fire prevention. Fuidoso fireman Robby Hall conifrns that every year, tocal firemen are caited to several chim-
ney fires. Many could have been prevented with a ney fires. Many
ilitte maintenance.
If your woodistove isn't drawing well, it's a sure sign It has too much creosote buildup. Shine a fiashlight through both ends of the chimney, and you'll see the through
problem.
There are several hardware stores where you can buy a chimney cleaning kit, or you can save yourself the hassle and mess and hire someone to do it. Professionials are likely to do a better job because they know more about pipe separations, etc.
Other tips inciude:

- check with a flashlight for separations in the chimney pipe;
- bum well-seasoned hardwood to reduce the amount of creosote (it's amazing how much more tar is produced by wood cut less than a year ago);
- make sure the top of your chimney has a spark arrestor because sparks can easily catch your roof on ilre, especially if you have a wood shingle roof -- and
if you have an arrestor, make sure there aren't any If you have
holes in it;
holes and' of course, you have to dispose of wood ashes regulariy, so atways put them in a metal conashes regulariy, so ewrays putiner, wet them down, and leave them a fow days before disposing of them in a community dumpster (this is another common reason for calls to the fire department).
