Feds offer money to drought-stricken ranchers here

The U.S. Department of Agricul ture will release some of its 45 mil lion bushels of feed grain reserves to help drought-stricken livestock producers in New Mexico and the Southwest, Sen. Pete Domenici an
The USDA will begin to make up to $\$ 40$ million in grain reserves stock producers.
The president declared the Southwest and other areas an emergency area July 1. With the declaration, the USDA can begin using its feed grain reserves as drought aid.
The USDA will sell up to 15 milion bushels of reserve grain. The proceeds from the grain sales will e used to make cost-share assistance available under the Disfrom now through September. New Merico livestock produce will be eligible if they have lost $40 \%$ or more of feed production, and do or more of sufficient feed available for livestock for the duration of the omergency.

## Deputy's jury trial begins

Molly McBrinn Foster, the first prosecution witness, described how as a drug informant for the deputs Vega never told her she had bee arrested for invalid charges, she testified.

Before Foster appeared and after seven men and seven women wer selected for the 12 -member, two alternate jury, attorneys presented their opposing views.

Defense attorney Bill Counts told jurors Vega followed regular procedures after the arrest of Foster and Shelly Woods for smug gling contraband in

Forest may reopen to timber harvesting

The Smokey Bear District of the Lincoln National Forest may be reopened to eommercial fuelorood cutters after an 11-month clasure, if a court-ordered injunction is lifted.
Despite an announcement Friday by Regional Forester Chip Cartwright that logging operations would rearme in national forests in Arizona and New Mexico, district ranger Jerry Hawkes said he had not received final word by Tuesday.
If and when he does receive word, the change won't have a huge effect on the Lincoln, he said. However, it will help out amall operations that provide wood for
omeowners.
We have no major logging in our district," Hawkes asid. "Most of cutters, about 30 of them."
The federal court-andered injumetion was in response to a suit filed by environmentalista to protect the habitat of the threatened Mexican spotted owl.

A vetrininarian as well as a top state elected official, Pomell wants to increase the panalties for animal crualty ly elevating the crime from a petty misdemeanor to a fourth degree felony.
The propoosal he hopes the state Lecisilature will support:

- adds paisoning of a person's own animal to the definition of cruelty to amimals;
- increases the penalty from six months in jaill and/or a $\$ 500$ fine to 18 months in prison and a \$5,000 cime;
- permits a judge to bar an offender from owning an animal for a period of time or permanently;
- increasea the penalty for injury to animals from a high misdemeanor (one year in jail and a $\$ 1,000$ fine) to a fourth degree felony;
-repeals the existing title and section of the maw called malicious slaughter of domestic canine animala (dealing with shooting doge that attack livestock) as redundant;
- and adds a new section of examptions.

The statute would not apply to godd animal hushandry practicos, lavful hunting and trapping, vildifif managument authorized by law, kiling of livestock under the state Livestock Act, good veterinary practices under the Veterinary Liconsing Act, rodeo performances, pest or rodent control and lawful scientifit or agricultural rasearch or education involving the use of animals.

You may want to express differing opinionis about the last two exemptions.
