## Mescalero arbitration with state delayed again

has refused to send state Apache tribe ambling revenues, saying 16 percent of slot machine profits is too high.

As far as H.L. Lovato knows, the Mescalero tribe has never sent money o the state, as mandated in both past and current gambling compacts. 'They haven't paid it to us, and would know," said Lovato, a spokesperson with the New Mexico Treasurer's Office.

Mescalero President Wendell Chino, who is out of town this week has in the past described the 16-per, cent revenue share requirement of the current gambling legislation as extor tion. He signed the tribe's gambling compact with the state under protest, hino has said.
The tribe has not submitted any of the past four quarterly payments to fees, Lovato said. But the tribe never made payments to the state under the 1995 gaming compact, either, when the rever
said.
"We have not received any kind of said "Hom the Mescalero," Lovato said. The Mescalero tribe is one of two in New Mexico that have not submitted payments under the current gaming compact. The other is the Jicarilla Apache tribe, Lovato said. Meanwhile, the remaining gaming tribes in the state have paid in a total of $\$ 26.5 \mathrm{mil}$. lion, according to information provided Oct. 26, he said.
Scott Spencer, the gambling representative for the state, said four of the remaining tribes have reverted to pay ing 5 percent of their revenues from

## Now, look very closely at jail financing

Maybe Carrizozo is the best site for a new Lincoln County jail, or "detention center," the politically correct name these days. Maybe not.

It doesn't really matter now, after the abrupt decision made by the Lincoln County Commission last Thursday that places the new jail in Carrizozo, most likely in the comnunity's industrial park.

The report on the jail, perhaps flawed as one commissioner claimed, was made available to the commission last Nednesday, a day before the commissioners voted.

It never was made available to the public - not to the majority of the public in a reasonable fashion anyway

What's the point of spending $\$ 10,000$ of the public's money on a report when the public is not allowed access to the report until it is too late to to serve any informational
purpose? Yes, they are under pressure from the state for jail purpose? Yes, the

Perhaps our county fathers, the same ones who haven't been able to conduct a meeting in the last few months without embarrassing someone (frequently themselves), know better than the people they were elected to represent.

This casts no aspersions on Carrizozo's people; they mounted a major lobbying effort to keep the jail, fearful that separation might in the future lead to loss of the courthouse, too, and the study concluded theirs was the best site.

The elected leaders of Ruidoso are not without fault however. Council members and Mayor Robert Donaldson should have expressed more interest in the facility, because something as major as a new jail facility inevitably will impact Ruidoso no matter where it is built-and especially so when financing is considered.

Although financing of the $\$ 470 \$ 5$ million pizquen has, been worked out, that consultant's study recommends a oneeighth percent increase in the gross receipts tax, which the commission could add without a vote. The consultants note that 80 percent of the tax would be generated in Ruidoso and that "transients" (read tourists) would pay some 60 percent of the total. But no assessment was made of the impact on tourism or other business development in the county as a result of a higher tax.

There are other options, and we hope the commissioners ake more time to consider these than they did the report. Meanwhile Commissioner Monroy Montes is asking for an apology from Commissioner William Schwettman for calling Commissioner Wilt
in a commission meeting.
We ask the Lincoln County Commission as a whole to apologize to the public for its past and present handling of something as important as the county jail.

When John Glenn orbited the Earth on Feb. 20, 1962, our country breathed a sigh of relief. The United States had finally caught up with the Soviet Union in the space race.
Glenn's flight also excited the world because it was one of the first times humans had ever left our home planet. His flight marked the dawn of a new age United States and the Soviet Union wo strained. The threat of war was very real. The United States and many other countries were worried. They feared the Soviets might use their leadership in space in case of a war.
We were lagging way behind. Glenn's successful flight came five years after the Soviets shocked the world with the launching of the irst artificial satellite, Sputnik I
On April 12,
1961, the Ruse 1961, the Russian scored another space victory. The Gagarin became

the first human to orbit the Earth. The United States finally got its man into space a month later. Astronaut Alan Shepard went up and came back, but did not orbit,

## POOP SCOOP

The fate of wild horses removed by the Bureau of Land Management from public lands in New Mexico and other parts of the West has caught the attention of the Humane Society of the United States.

In the society's Summer 1998 magazine, the author of an article on the issue said reports of their treatment are grim and include allowing horses to die of thirst and starvation.
"BLM records for 32,000 adopted horses in the Adopt-AHorse program have been lost," the, author writes. "Thousands of horses have been sold to slaughter."

The BLM has struggled since the passed in 1971 of the Wild Free-Roaming Horse \& Burro Protection Act to fulfill the mandate to keep public lands healthy while protecting the wild horses, other wildlife and livestock, according to the article.

Under the adoption program, BLM employees and contractors drive the wild horses into corrals on the open range. Some eventually are released back onto the range, but others are trucked to holding facilities for adoption by private individuals, who are suppose to be screened and educated to ensure they can humanely care for the horses.

Since 1992, the HSUS has worked with the BLM to slow the growth rates of western wild-horse herds using immunocontraception. The shot can be administered by hand injection quickly and cheaply to mares and the society hopes it will reduce the need for roundups and the number of horses entering the adoption stream.

Three field projects were begun in 1997-98 in Oregon and Nevada to test a new version of a one-shot, one-year vaccine and to demonstrate that population control can be achieved.

HSUS Senior Scientist Allen Ruthberg has been appointed to the BLM's Wild Horse and Burro Advisory Board, according to the article. The board is charged with recommending to BLM director: Pat Shea on a range of issues.
"The HSUS is committed to helping the new, reform-minded BLM directorship to change fundamentally the structure and culture of the BLM wild-horse program, restore public rangelands, secure a fair share of the land's resources for wild horses and burros and ensure a decent life for animals, who must be removed from the range," the author wrote.

## KIDS AND CORRECTIVE LENSES

Although most children between the ages of 3 and 18 receive some sort of vision screening through their school system，eách child should be seen annual－ ly by a licensed Doctor of Optometry．While screening does provide an indica－ tion for corrective lenses，it does not tell about eye health，depth perception， color vision or comprehensive eye health and vision examination．Other condi－ tions including strabismus（abnormal alignment of the two eyes or turned eye）， amblyopia（poor sight in one eye）and emmetropia（good vision at distance but not at near）usually require corrective lenses．Children who have eye problems are occasionally misdiagnosed with Attention Deficit Disorder（ADD）or other conditions that don＇t necessarily address their vision．Vision therapy such as eye exercises or vision training may help correct certain visual disorders and thus make visual tasks，especially reading，enjoyable．

Lenses for children are often made of plastic material．However，a polycar－ bonate lens is recommended since it is the most impact－resistant and thus the safest lens available．Glass lenses should never be used for children．Prisms can be a heipful tool for enabling a child who experiences double vision． Asperic lenses can reduce the effect of magnifying the eye in high plus powers and make lenses thinner and lighter．

There has been an éxplosion of shows about big Irish-American families on TV this fall, but To Have \& to Hold is surely the most romantic.
Debuting Wednesday, Sept. 30, on CBS, Have stars Jason Beghe and Moira Kelly as a couple about to begin the rest of their lives together in the most romantic way: by getting married.
"It seems like, on television, if you're married, sex stops, romance stops," executive producer Scott Shepherd observes. "And what we're trying to say is that, basically, marriage is a very romantic thing."
In the pilot episode, public defender Annie Cornell (Kelly) is putting the last touches on her plans to marry Boston police detective Sean McGrail (Beghe), whom she has known since childhood. In fact, Annie's older sister, Carolyn (Colleen Flynn), already is married to Patrick McGrail (Stephen Lee), one of Sean's brothers.
Since the couple will remain in the neighborhood where they grew up their romance has a communal side as well as a private one. They, know everyone on their block, and everyone knows them.
Thesdriving force, behind Have is writer Joanne Waters, a daughter of the Irish working-class neighborhood where the show is set.
"I only write about what I know about I'm not going to write about a farm family in lowa," says Waters, who spent several uncomfortable weeks last winter trying to fit intoglhe writing staff of Dawson's Creek.
Im not into the Sturm und Drang drama aspect, and I'm not yucking it up (with this show), either," she says. "I think that life is humorous and trag. ic at the same time.
After writing The Doyles, a family drama that almost made it onto CBS schedule last season, Waters hit pay dirt when she reworked the concept to focus on romance.
"It's not the type of show where (you wonder,) 'Are they going to get married, or are they not going to get mar-

ried?' It's sort of how two people join together and try to get to the same goal," Waters says.
"And then we have the couple who has children and who are dealing with all those kind of issues."
In the tradition of "women's movies" of decades gone by, Have promises never to turn into a cop show. It isn't about an exclusively lrish experience, either, Shepherd explains.
"We see it as a relationship show about a marriage and this couple and their family. The themes that go through it should be universal.
"We try to start with something that's going on between the two of them in their relationship," he continues. "And then we try to find the cop-and-lawyer story that will give us the playground basically, to explore those themes. (Sean and Annie will) talk about the case, which is a way for them to work out what's going on between them."
Sean and Annie's relationship is definitely a passionate one, both when they're enjoying marital bliss and when they're butting heads in disagreement. It all seems completely natural to Waters, who grew up in a community where even the girls had fistrights.
In the end, though, love will conquer all. Romance, as Shepherd defines it, is "what couples do for each other when they love each other. And that's what we're trying to (show) every week."
