Peeling back the layers of debate, at heart is this question: Is Ruidoso a tourist town or residential/retirement comboth. The "solution" to the problems facing the shortterm rental industry, therefore, is not going to please all
parties. parties. does set in mance, however, ulations and requiremedts to help codify an industry that had expanded under the radar to an estimated 900 properties, some of them "rene gades."
Whether the "overlay" approach is a good one will be among items reviewed by the one year. That review should help reassure all sides

"That first episode packs a big punch," Brown says. When telling friends about the plot, she says they think she's describing the first season, and it's actually all in the premiere
Brown describes her character Brown describes her character as "impulsive, impetuous. What she is trying to do best is keep it all together. She is feisty, flirty, sometimes quite frazzled but a whole lot of fun.
Now that the Canadian show is moving to the States, Brown says the action could unfold in any North American city. The show has been well received in Canada (where it is produced and broadcast by CBC Television). and the cast just finished shooting the second season.

The reaction to the first season was great, positive, says Spence. "It took us a while to find out what we were doing. Well, it's pretty obvious what Rick is doing, and it marks him as a cad By the end of the pilot, though when Sophie delivers her baby, it's clear that not all of the babe for the failed relation the blame

"That was the problem with the character -- no one has anything nice to say about him," Spence says. Megan Mullally samples 'Motherhood' in Web-inspired sitcom

 © Zap2it.Just from her award-winning work as Karen on "Will \& Grace," it's clear that Megan Mullally would not be the typical mom. The lively actress-singer demonstrates that as one of the women fronting "In the Motherhood," an ABC comedy series premiering Thursday, March 26. The show has an atypical source for its stories: the general public, since script ideas are drawn from people's actual experiences submitted on the program's Web site (www.inthemotherhood.com).
In fact, the sitcom has its roots in an online show that started two years ago, with Cheisea Handler, Jenny McCarthy and Leah Remini ("The King of Queens") as women at various stages of parenting. Now those roles go to Mullálly, Cheryl Hines ("Curb Your Enthusiasm") and Jessica St. Clair ("Worst Week")
Mullally plays Rosemary, a seri-al-bride nonconformist whose behavior might not be deemed the best influence on her teenage son, Syd (Ryan Pinkston). To the great surprise of struggling fellow-mom sisters Jane and Emily (Hines, St. Clair), Syd appears better equipped to field life's däly challenges than his mother.
II wouldn't have wanted to.play another character similar to Karen Walker," two-time Emmy winner Mullally says of the high-pitched-in-all-ways part she's best known for, "but beyond that, I'm really not super-picky. I've seen a lot of actors who were on long-running shows kind of get paralyzed, afraid to make the next move and (worried) whether it's the right or wrong one, then you just never hear from them again.
"My approach is much less scientific: If something comes along that feels like it would be good to do, then I do it. The great thing about this is that we have great chemistry in the cast. That's something we had on 'Will \& Grace,' too, and it's rare. You can't go into something expecting that, but right now, I think that's our ace in the hole."
Not a mom in real life, Mullally also apprectates "in the

Motherhood" taking its creative direction from "anything anyone wants to submit-their-stories about kooky, crazy family things. I watched the Web series, and I thought it was really cute."
Mullally adds that ABC wants its "Motherhood" to be "edgier" than the Web forerunner, "and it's still evolving, as is my charācter. She wears leather jackets and motorcycle boots; she's a tough mama, and she's 50 and she owns it. I like playing people who don't have the same self-censorship that others have. It's not that this woman says mean things to other people; she's just more adventurous and a risk taker, which I like."
"Saturday Night Live" alum Horatio Sanz and RonReaco Lee ("Madea Goes to Jail") also are in "in the Motherhood," which relies in part on improvisation. another big lure for Mullally.
"Basically," she explains, "we get a script, then we have a rehearsal, then we rehearse again and improvise off the script. Then the writers take some of our improvisations and incorporate them into the script, we'll shoot that as written, then we'll do takes where we improvise. It gives us a lot of room to experiment and have fun."
Getting back to steady television work means giving up the freeagent status Mullaliy has enjoyed lately. She did guest shots on NBC's "30 Rock" and CBS' "The New Adventures of Old Christine"; she starred on Broadway in the musical version of Mel Brooks' "Young Frankenstein"; and she recorded her third album ("Free Again!") with her group, Supreme Music Program.
Those followed Mullally's 2006 07 stint as the host of a syndicated weekday talk show, which she recalls as "a really good experience. I learned a lot about what I want to do and what I don't wan to do. It was so much work, the kind of work that can really take a toll on you.
"The one thing I really didn't fee comfortable about was having my name all over the show. That's not my style, and it also wasn't the kind of creative envronment I'm used to. The busi-ness-of-the-business aspect is fine, but it's not really me."

Mullally isn't the only person in her household with a new series; her husband, actor Nick Offerman, stars with "Saturday Night Live" veteran Amy Poehler in NBC's upcoming show "Parks \& Recreation." Also in Mullally's future is a role in this fall's movie remake of the musical drama "Fame," but for the moment, it's mainly "Motherhood" for her.
"I feel lucky," Mullally reflects, "because I have a few different things I enjoy doing, a few options. That absolutely opens up other avenues for me. You're always accruing experience and that helps. but with every job you do, it's like starting from square one. I feel l've done so many things, but every new job is a new world."

# For Kids' Choice nominees, it's the slime of their lives

The Oscars boast the most glamour, the Grammys the best music, the Tonys an amazing show, but the Kids' Choice Awards has the corner on fun and slime.

Ben Sifler as Alex -in Madagascar: Escape 2 Africa. What parent would not allow his or her children to watch a show honoring books? In the favorite book category, kids choose from "Diary of a Wimpy Kid," "Diary of a Wimpy Kid Do-lt-Yourself Book," the "Harry Potter" series and the "Twilight" series.
Reflecting on his first-time hosting duties, Johnson .says, "I'm not nervous, just uber excited. This is the first time l ever hosted and the first time I ever used the word uber' in a sentence
"Sure, I have been to the show, and nominated a couple of times," Johnson continues. "The opportu. nity to host was great.
"I have never been slimed," he says. "So if, in fact, I am called upon for that wonderful honor, I will do it with much pride.'
The former wrestler once known as The Rock, now an actor in films such as "Get Smart" and "Race to Witch Mountain," is not alone. Serena Williams, the world's topranked women's tennis player. longs to be slimed.
I have always wanted to be slimed," Williams says, then laughs. "Mary-Kate and Ashley, the Olsen twins, got slimed. I'm OK with getting slimed. Please, slime me! ${ }^{\text {² }}$
As she so often is, Williams is pitted against sister Venus for tavorite female athlete Race-car driver Danica Patrick and basketball star Candace Parker round out the category.

With the exception-of-ine-Oscars. and the Emmys, Williams says he has been to "pretty much every other award. They are so intense. With the Kids Choice Awards, you can go in your jeans and just be yourself and not worn too much about what designer to wear, It's just about being you and being normal. That's my favorite hing about the Kids' Choice Awards."
Miranda Cosgrove, the 15 -yearold star of the cablenet's hit "Carly," also adores this show. This is her seventh time there and her first as a nominee for favorite elevision actress. She's up against Miley Cyrus for "Hannah Montana," America Ferrera for "Ugly Betty" and Selena Gomez or "Wizards of Waverly Place"
Cosgrove has one over Williams and Johnson -- she's been slimed "One year I went with friends, and the seats we had weren't sup posed to be slimed," Cosgrove says. "But we got slime all over our dresses. I consider myself a slime expert now. It's just gooey and slippery and green."
It's touted as edible, but Cosgrove did not taste it. Though Nickelodeon won't divulge the slime's secret ingredients, a network representative says tha homemade slime can be concoct ed from applesauce, vanllla pud ding, oatmeal and green food dye "It left a little bit of a green tint," on her skin, Cosgrove says. "tt came out of the dress. Whatever it is, it' not too serious."

Cosgrove is singing at the preshow, a far cry from her first year, when she was star-struck upon seeing Raven. Cosgrove like most teenage girls, says if she could meet anyone at the Kids Choice, it would be Rob Pattinson of "Twilight."
That's a long shot considering he is not nominated for favorite movie actor. The nominees here are Jim Carrey for "Yes Man," George Lopez for "Beverly Hills Chihuahua," Adam Sandler for "Bedtime Stories" and Will Smith for "Hancock,"
Host Johnson says, "I can't wait to meet Clint Eastwood." No word on whether Eastwood will attend, but Johnson is bringing his daughter and her pals, who are already excited.
"The great thing about the show is not only the endless enthusiasm that the kids have for it," Johnson says. "it seems like the goal for an hour and a half is for kids to scream as loud as they can." And Johnson's goal? "I would love to see -- aside from the great per formances we are going to get -- I would tove to see the maximum number of kids getting slimed And kids as in our audience, and not necessarily the celebrities." Johnson has but one condition for the show. "I don't want to not have fun," he says. "Let's all perform without inhibition. Let it all hang out for the kids."

## Information for expectant parents

The appearance of a plus sign，two lines，or whatever pregnancy test indicator informs a woman that she is expecting can signal a time of change and excitement．If this is a first pregnancy，you may be unaware of what to expect．While no one wants to think of complications arising early on in the pregnancy，it＇s important to be aware of certain warning signs and consult with your doctor if you experience any odd conditions．A situation that may occur in the first trimester of pregnancy of which many women are unaware is a subchorionic hemorrhage．Also known as a subchorionic hematoma，subchorionic bleed or clot，a subchorionic hemorrhage（SCH）is the most common sono－ graphic abnormality in the presence of a live embryo．It is estimated that 25 to 40 percent of all women will experience some sort of bleeding during the first trimester of preg nancy．An SCH is often the cause．An SCH is a collection of fluid and blood that forms between the uterine wall and the chorionic membrane．While there is no concrete cause，

some surmise it occurs during egg implantation. The egg slightly separates or tearsf from the uterus causing a bleed. There is nothing a woman did or could have done to cause or prevent them. An SCH is a risk early in pregnancy because the blood clot itself can cause a miscarriage. The ciot can release completely from the uterus and cause the fetus and placenta to miscarry. According to WebMD, pregnant women with a demonstrable hematoma have a prognosis worse than women without a hematoma. The outcome of the fetus depends on the size of the hematoma, the mother's age, and the fetus' gestational aye. Rates of miscarriage increase with advancing maternal age and increasing size of hematoma. Treatment for an SCH varies among doctors and there is no definitive cure for the condition. Nature simply has to take its course. Most hematomas resolve themselves by 20 weeks of pregnancy: ether being reabsorbed or bled out. Doctors may suggest you go on with your normal activities. Others advise you take it easy, meaning no heavy lifting, frequent resting, no exercise, and no sexual intercourse. Bed rest may be suggested if deemed necessary. With frequent doctor check-ups and care on the part of the mother, many pregnancies go on to full term despite an SCH. Do not hesitate to call your doctor and assuage your fears.
