Democratic County Convention

A convention of the Democrats of Lincoln county, New Mexico, is hereby called to meet at the Court House, in Carrizozo, N. M., at 10 a. m. Saturday September 25th, 1920, for the purpose of selecting candidates for the following offices: Sheriff, Assessor, Treasurer, Clerk, Probate Judge, School Superintendent, Surveyor, Commissioner, one each from first, second and third districts.

Also to select a candidate for representative to the House of Representatives the New Mexico Legislature.

Precinct primaries to be held not later than September 20th, 1920, notice of primaries to be printed in local papers wherever possible.

A County Chairman, a Vice County Chairman, and County Secretary of the Democratic Central Committee will be selected at this Convention.

All delegates are requested to be present in person. Proxy can only be exercised by present voter of the precinct represented.

The basis of representation is one delegate for every ten votes or majority fraction thereof cast for the party at the last general election in 1918.

C. N. Morris for Commissioner.

The announcement of C. N. Morris, known by many as "Doc Morris, the saw mill man," for County Commissioner from District No. 1, appears in this issue of the Mountaineer. Mr. Morris has been a resident of Lincoln county for the past eighteen years and is well known to many of the voters of the county. He is a native of Texas, lived a short time in Oklahoma, then came to Lincoln county, New Mexico, where he engaged in the saw mill business and supplied lumber to a large scope of country. His candidacy is subject to the action of the democratic convention, and will see all the voters he can between this time and the date of the convention. Mr. Morris was induced to make the race for Commissioner at the urgent solicitation of many of his friends and acquaintances who believe him in every way capable to make a good county commissioner. We ask the democratic voters not only of his own district but of the other districts in the county to give Mr. Morris' candidacy the consideration that it justly deserves and if nominated and elected he will make them one of the best commissioners the county has ever had.

Republican County Convention

The Republicans of Lincoln county held their county convention to select delegates to the state convention in Capitán last Friday. Wm. E. Blanchard was chairman of the convention and J. V. Tully secretary.

The committee on resolutions, of which L. W. White was chairman and A. L. secretary, reported a series of resolutions charging the democratic party with many delinquencies and particularly condemned the administration of President and his policy in regard to the League of Nations.

The convention endorsed the administration of Governor Larrazola, endorsed Senator Fall and Representative Hernandez.

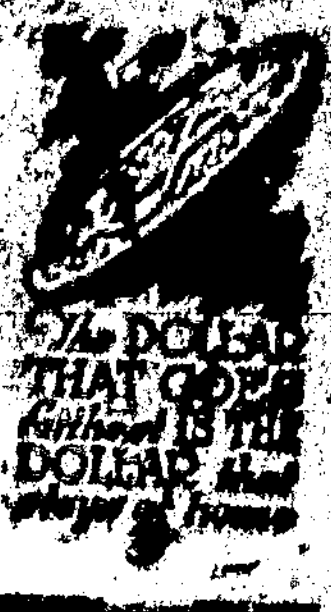
