THE FREE GOLD ALRIGHT. GOLD NEAR CAPITAN.

Mr. Byrd Well Pleased With His New Klondyke Property.

A. R. Byrd the Bonito mining man spent several hours in Capitan last Thursday, having arrived the night before from a few days' visit to El Paso. Mr. Byrd when seen by a representative of the Progress seemed to be in excellent spirits. Mr. Byrd is as a very careful man in both what he says and does and when questioned in regard to his Bonito properties made only guarded replies. He, however, had the following to say: "There has not been enough work done on the Free Gold to show just what it will develop into though so far everything continues favorable and I am very well pleased with the property. Joe Stanfield has a very promising copper proposition five miles west of this place which he is working. He has sunk a shaft on the lead to a depth of about 65 feet and has about two car loads of ore on the dump which is said to carry good values. The vein at the surface was about six feet wide but has since narrowed down to about two feet. But as vein decreased in width it has increased in richness.

PEREA BROUGHT BACK

He Does Not Like Mexico and Comes Back Willingly.

Postoffice Inspector C. L. Doran of the Denver office, arrived in El Paso last night from Chihuahua, Mexico, having in custody Demetrio Perea, the absconding postmaster at Lincoln, N. M.

Perea absconded last November leaving a shortage of two thousand dollars, having embezzled the money order funds of his office to that amount. He fled to Old Mexico and has since been followed by Doran, who at last located him at Chihuahua, where he was under the assumed name of Benito Gonzales.

The officer spent ten days in Mexico several weeks ago and then returned empty handed. In the meantime Perea had been to Mexico City and as far south as Vera Cruz.

Inspector Doran left El Paso several days ago with extradition papers from Governor Otero, of New Mexico on Governor Ahumada, of Chihuahua. Last Friday the inspector located his man at the mining camp of Santa Eulalia, fifteen miles west of Chihuahua, and on the same day he received word from Governor Ahumada that the extradition papers would not be honored, owing to some informality.

Doran then went to Santa Eulalia and found Perea there. A crowd of miners gathered around them and threatened to prevent the removal of Perea but Perea himself told them he was willing to go and for them not to interfere. Perea then accompanied the officer to Chihuahua and then to El Paso.

This morning Perea was turned over to Deputy U. S. Marshal Hildebrand and later arraigned before U. S. Commissioner Hove and his bond fixed at \$5,000.

Perea has already been indicted

for embezzling government funds and will be tried at Socorro, New Mexico, in April. He was formerly county clerk and also sheriff of Lincoln county and was a political leader there.

Since he fled from the States Perea has traveled several thousand miles and when found by Inspector Doran had grown a full beard and would not have been recognized by any of his friends. -El Paso Herald.



The first shipment of freight over the new route direct to Capitan was received this week. It was a consignment of liquors for Aragon Bros. & Co., of Lincoln and came all of the way by local freight from Kansas City.

**and Industries of Lincoln County.**

Providence has done more and man has done less for Lincoln county than for any section of the southwest. We can say it without fear of successful contradiction, that Lincoln county is richer in natural resources than any other section in the territory.

## CHARLESTON EXPOSITION.

Specimens Wanted for a New Mexico  
Exhibit.

Albuquerque, N. M.  
Feb. 6, 1902.

DEAR SIR:

I presume that you have  
seen in the Albuquerque paper  
which you get, the effort made  
to raise enough money to secure  
an exhibit for New Mexico at the  
Charleston exposition. I am very  
glad to say that the public-spirited  
citizens of Albuquerque have  
responded very nobly, and the  
\$500.00 necessary is practically  
secured. There is a small amount  
yet to be raised, but I think  
that we will be able to raise it.  
This is a work which ought to  
be done by the citizens of the  
territory at large, but I had  
no time to properly solicit  
subscriptions from them and was  
obliged to confine my attention  
to Albuquerque. The New Mex-  
ico Commission, appointed by  
Governor Otero, consists of  
William H. Pope, Chairman,  
Santa Fe, Arthur H. Harillee,  
Vice-Chairman, Silver City, R.  
W. D. Bryan, Sec. and Treas.,  
Albuquerque, Hugh N. Wilcox,  
Santa Fe, and Ava E. Page,  
Roswell.

Unfortunately the Territorial  
Legislature made no appropriation  
for the use of the commis-  
sion. We have however collected  
a large amount of ore from the  
different mining districts in New  
Mexico, and we will now have a  
very creditable exhibit. The  
Hyde Exploring company will  
take charge of it. They will  
make in connection with this an  
exhibit of their own consisting of  
blankets, pottery and Indian  
baskets, and will also have from  
twelve to fifteen Indians weaving  
blankets and manufacturing silver  
ornaments. They will install the  
New Mexico exhibit, furnish  
tables, showcases, shelving, lab-  
els and mottoes, and we will give  
them as a part payment of the ex-  
pense the sum of \$500.00. Now  
that the exhibit is assured, I am  
very anxious to have it as full  
and complete as possible. I write  
herefore to you to request that  
you will use the influence of your  
paper and your personal influence  
in getting your constituents to  
furnish exhibits for the exposition.  
We would like to have ores, grain,  
wines, fruits and vegetables in  
their season. At present I pre-  
sume, the bulk of the exhibit will  
have to be of ores. It is quite  
important for New Mexico to  
make a full and complete exhibit  
of its varied mineral products.

The Santa Fe Railroad company  
has very graciously agreed to ship  
free of charge all exhibits ad-  
dressed to me at this point. All  
the agents of the company have

instructions to that effect. So  
that all your readers will have to  
do is to take their exhibits to the  
agent of the Santa Fe, and he  
will take charge of them and ship  
them to me free of charge. I will  
then see that they are sent to  
Charleston. The advantages to  
the Territory at large from this  
exhibit will be that it will be an  
advertisement which will attract  
the attention of men of means and  
thus induce capital and people to  
come into our Territory. It will  
also attract the attention of the  
throng of tourists who annually  
go from the north to spend the  
Spring months in Florida. It  
will also gain for us the good will  
of the senators and representa-  
tives from the southeast in Con-  
gress, and thus aid the statehood  
bill. I would be very glad if you  
would do your part in having ex-  
hibits sent to me. I would like  
to have them as soon as possible.  
We hope to get off the first car-  
load within the next ten days,  
but if exhibits come later, I will  
ship them at any time. You will  
also bear in mind that this ex-  
hibit will be at the close of the  
Charleston, sent to the world's  
fair at St. Louis. I assure you  
that I appreciate the work of the  
newspaper men in developing New

you confidently, and knowing that  
this enterprise will receive your  
heartly cooperation. It would  
please me if you would send me a  
marked copy of your paper which  
may contain a notice of this enter-  
prise, and appeal to your readers  
to contribute towards the success  
of this exhibit.


