The bill for the admission of Arizona, New Mexico and Oklahoma passed the house last Saturday by a unanimous vote.

David M. Esty, former manager at the Esty City copper mines in Socorro county has filed a petition in bankruptcy in a Detroit Michigan, Court. His liabilities are placed at \$170,000 and his assets at \$10,000.

The statehood bill which passed the house of congress last week, must yet pass the senate before the people of New Mexico can get a chance to vote on it. There is not much probability that the senate will take up the bill at this session but there is little doubt about its passage by that body in December.

A number of Republicans in the county are urging Robert A. Hurt, the Capitan druggist and justice of the peace, to allow his name to go before the people as a candidate for the office of sheriff, subject to the will of the Republican county convention. So far Mr. Hurt has not publicly announced his willingness to make the race. We have known Mr. Hurt personally for some time and find him to be a gentleman in every respect and thoroughly competent to fill any office in the county.

The Fifth Judicial district can boast of having a most competent set of court officials as can be found in any of the older states. Hon. D. H. McMillan, the presiding judge, is deserving of the highest compliments for his able and impartial construction of the law and unbiased rulings. The court clerk Mr. J. E. Griffith, is the most competent and obliging we have had, and Col. G. W. Pritchard, as prosecuting attorney commands the honor and respect of everyone who desires to see justice meted out to saint and sinner alike. Under the present court, taxes are being reduced rapidly and our court dockets are being closed up fast and equitably. If we do obtain statehood (and we trust it will soon come) the Fifth district wants no change in court officials, unless it might be to place some of the present incumbents into higher and more lucrative positions.
